## 10-Year Project for Jerome's BPW Ends; Finish Fireplace

JEROME, July 20—A project started nearly 10 years ago by the Women's club was brought to fulfillment this week with the completion of the first city park fireplace. The fireplace will be given to the city of Jerome by the club this month with special ceremonies.

The fireplace, which is made of local stone, has a base of five feet wide and four feet high. It is 10 feet long and eight feet tall, having five points with five fireplaces and five chimneys. It is built of local stone and rock taken from the craters near the ice caves above Shoshone. Each rock was selected by the members and hauled by Joe Rose who built the fireplace. Rose says the largest rock in the fireplace is 40 inches in diameter and weighs approximately 150 pounds. It is four inches thick. All stones used in the fireplace were used in the construction.

The base of the fireplace is 18 inches high and 24 inches wide. A granite plaque, presented by the Business and Professional Women's club, 1959, has been installed on the base of the fireplace. The plaque was donated by Abe and Edna Miller.

Cost of the project is approximately \$1,000 and much of the money raised for the club for the fireplace was gained by annual annual

fundraising drives.





