WASHINGTON—The first and most immediate effect of the Korean "invasion" and preparations for other emergencies will be a huge increase in the stability deposit fund.

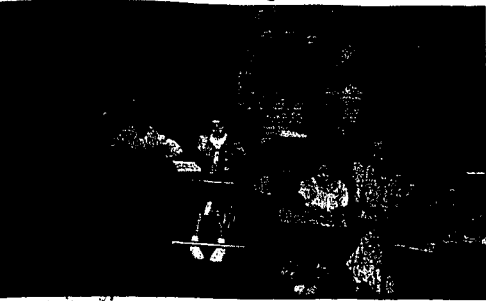
