

Britain Supports U. S. in Council on Korean Issue

SUCCESS, Aug. 2 (AP)—Britain supported the United States today in demanding that China be pushed aside and that the Korean conflict be given priority in the Security Council. The British ambassador, Sir Gladwyn Jebb called the Korean question the "gravest and most important" that the 11-nation security council resumed debate on whether it should act first.

All Voters

U. S. Troops Gain Ground Near Chinju; Army Plans to Boost Strength to 1,000,000 by 1951

WASHINGTON, Aug. 2 (AP)—The army will boost its strength by the least 170,000 men, it was learned today. This would be at least 170,000 above the goal outlined only last week, and more than 400,000 above present strength.

It also was disclosed that the marine corps is shooting for nearly 180,000 men instead of the previously announced goal of 129,000.

Pressure from congress and elsewhere, it was learned may move the joint chiefs of staff to boost the marine figure higher.

Chiefman Carl Vinson of the house armed services committee said he is pushing for 200,000 Marines. At the same time, the Georgia Democrat predicted that the army eventually will mobilize "well over the 1,000,000 total."

The army's new manpower goal presumably will mean more draft calls and numerous additional national guard divisions to duty later in the year.

The army already has called for 20,000 draftees in September and 20,000 in October. And it has called four guard divisions to duty next month.

The army's new manpower goal was reconstituted to fill the ranks of regular divisions and elite units not now at full strength. Supporting units also need to be brought up to full strength.

The marine corps will have 104,000 regular divisions and elite units, and will increase its air squadrons above the present 10,000.

Vinson said his own goal for the army is 250,000 men and about 25 divisions.

The army ordered the four guard divisions to get in trim for their return to active duty.

TOKYO, Aug. 2 (Thursday)—The U. S. 24th division troops recaptured hill positions northeast of Chinju and held on today in a flaming battle 40 miles from the main port of Pusan.
