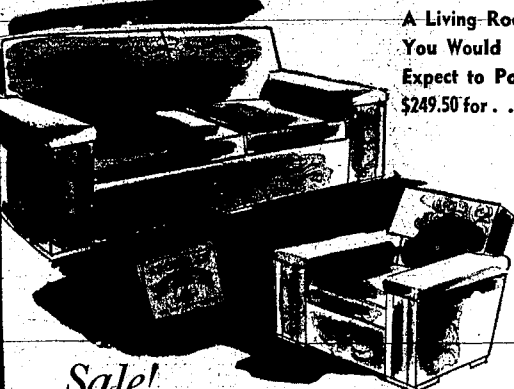

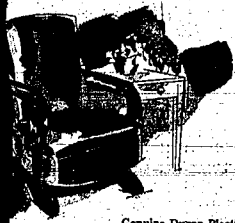

Communism in China reaches for the same territory which Russia has made her own. It is the same as the Communists take part of it, as in the case of Manchuria and Mongolia.

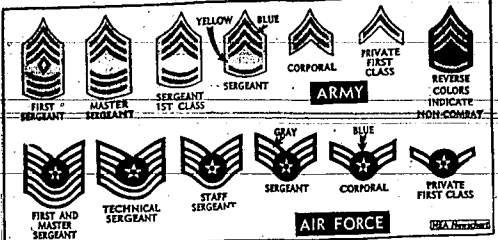
