TOKYO, Sunday, Aug. 13 (AP)—The Korean communists' greatest offensive since the invasion of North Korea appeared developing today along the thinly-defended Naktong river. General MacArthur's headquarters said some 60,000 reds were moving into attacking positions. North Korean tanks and artillery rumbled forward along a 20-mile front north and south of Waegwan, river town 12 air miles northwest of the communications hub of Taegu. At least 12,000 communists had filtered across the Naktong in the last American headquarters said was a "confused" situation on this most critical front. **Efforts by County Agent C. W. Daugh in secure control for the blight which has been causing extensive damage to lawns throughout the area for the past few years, has been rewarded by a recommendation from the entomologist that the blight be killed by the use of DDT.**

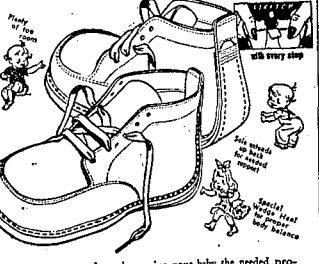

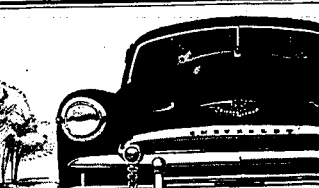
