# Korean Reds' Casualties Soar Over 11,000 in Bid To Crack U.N. Defenses

TOKYO, (Tuesday), Aug. 22 (AP)—Communist casualties, totaling a minimum of 11,000 and possibly as high as 15,000 in three days, soared Monday as the North Korean reds strove in desperation to crack the United Nations defense lines in South Korea.

Despite their punishing losses, mostly in dead, the red invaders were continuing to mass men and to probe the lines on the central and southern fronts for the big push which Americans predict may be their last. They are under orders from their high command to wipe out the defense by Aug. 31.

At one point north of Taegu on the northeastern front the reds made a tough two-mile gain before being halted by a brilliant night air-aided operation. Today, however, Gen. Douglas MacArthur's Tokyo headquarters omitted its usual early morning communiqué, saying the situation had not changed since.

Drop 'Success' Threat  
Significantly, the North Korean communique, broadcast by the Communist radio, declared "total success" there and complained that the American and Soviet forces were "in a counter-attack on all sectors."

Tokyo headquarters put the total reds killed and captured at 11,000 on Friday and Saturday at 10,000.

The reds had only an unimpeded advance of 100 miles from the part of the 2000 caseload, as being inflicted on the enemy in the region of the Nakdong.

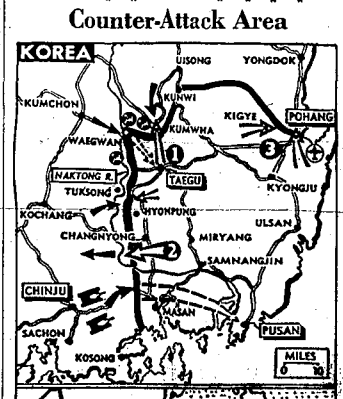

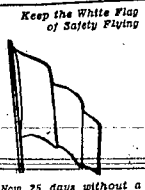

### Hoover Plan Going Ahead At Fast Rate

As one spokesman of the Citizens Committee for the Hoover Reorganization non-profit educational body seeking to save the governmental streamlining plan to Congress, said today.

From the point of view of the average westerner the most important and controversial administrative reform remains to be considered during the next Congress. This is the proposed transfer of the civil functions of the army department to the department of the interior.

Some irrigation and flood control projects estimate his single change, vitally affecting the lives of millions of people in 11 western states, could save up to a billion dollars annually.

### Efforts Dilapidated

Briefly this proposal would attempt to eliminate the present duplication of effort which not infrequently both army and reclamation bureau engineers make identical plans and project surveys of the same area. There are scores of instances where duplicate Canada surveys are made on the same river within two miles of each other and at a cost of \$20,000 or more for each one.

Even though these two agencies may be working on the same project, they are not infrequently making the same time their own estimates are often \$200,000 apart. There are now \$32,000,000 worth of these overlapping studies of proposed water and power developments filed away in these competing executive agencies.

Significant fact: The score on the last reorganization project is significant in the insight it gives into congress's approach to the problem. In approving any of the Hoover suggestions for reorganizing an executive agency the average congressman seems very anxious to conform to the specific ideas of the bipartisan Hoover commission.

The Citizens Committee takes pride in pointing out all 20 of the Hoover suggestions approved reorganization measures were certified by their legislative staffs. Only four were approved by the Hoover body's record of the last seven proposals all acted upon in the last session of congress.

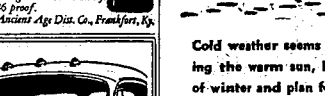

### Truman Aides Speed Drives For Rearing

WASHINGTON, Aug. 21 (AP)—The Truman administration will drive on two fronts this week for a speed-up of western rearmament to meet any threat of Soviet aggression in Europe.

In a message, Secretary of State Acheson will appear before the senate appropriations committee today to request the rearmament fund and an emergency \$400,000,000 foreign arms aid fund to strengthen American allies in Europe, the middle east and the far east.

Tomorrow, Acheson's deputy, Charles M. Spofford, from Truman's conference with President Truman, will meet in London with representatives of the North Atlantic treaty nations to urge that they greatly expand their defense programs.

The United States is taking an extraordinary firm position in its dealings with Britain, France and the other treaty powers because of the danger of a Soviet conquest of western Europe.

Acheson is expected to stress the United States in his appearance before the senate committee, urging that the United States especially should not lose the momentum in defense preparations which it picked up last winter in meeting the Korean crisis.

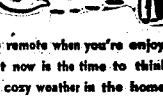
