TOKYO, (Saturday), Sept. 2 (AP) — Reinforced American troops, under one of the greatest air umbrellas of the war, smashed back at an estimated 50,000 attacking communists today. In the first phase of their counterattack they recaptured the ruined and smoking town of Haman on the extreme southwestern front.

The drive to retake Haman, lost in the first blow of an all-out communist attempt to drive the allies into the sea, began at 4 p. m. yesterday (Friday). By 8 p. m., the town, on the route to our vital supply base of Pusan, had been retaken on its westward side.

But, despite the furious pounding they were taking from the air and the fact we were able to counter-attack in the south, the red offensive showed no sign of letting up.

### Barkley Sets Pinchhit Job For Truman

WASHINGTON, Sept. 1 (AP)—Vice President Barkley was lined up today to pinchhit for President Truman in an active campaign to recruit Democratic members of Congress.

Barkley told a reporter he has ready to open next October speak for Democratic senate and congressmen in a dozen or more states where control of Congress is to be decided in the November election.

The Democratic national committee still is working on the schedule for the vice president said he is not certain to appear in Pennsylvania, Connecticut, New York, Indiana, Illinois, Missouri, Colorado, Utah, Washington and California.

Eight Democratic and five Republican senators are involved in one of those states, which also are in the 612 congressmen, though Barkley would not comment on the point, the understanding is he will step into the campaign to bat for President Truman while plans to cover most of states in "white stop" tours are canceled after the Korean cease-fire.

William M. Boyd, Jr., the Democratic national chairman, has said Truman may make some radio spots for Democratic candidates but has indicated there won't be presidential tours.

The president's friends feel that commander in chief Mr. Truman was limited in making partisan speeches.

### Grim Picture Presented by Crash Scene

IN THE EGYPTIAN DESERT NORTHWEST OF CAIRO, Sept. 1 (AP)—Charred bodies and a mass of junk were all that was to be found on this little patch of desert after a Trans-World Airlines Constellation crashed and burned.

The wreckage of the plane and the unrecognizable bodies were strewn over a black patch 100 yards long and 60 yards wide astride the "Delta flight railway," a narrow-gauge line Egyptian desert.

Scattered over the rectangle on the blinding, unmercifully hot desert, were bodies, bits and pieces of airplane, and a few trunks. Twenty of the bodies were in what was left of the landing gear. The rest were spread over 100 yards of sand. The bodies of three children were in a group. Most of the victims were naked. All were burned.

I came to the scene with a rescue party sent out by TWA. We travelled by car until we reached the village of Desha. There we met a bedouin, who saw the crash.

"Huge Red Bird"  
"It looked like a huge red bird flying through the night," he said. The plane appeared to catch fire in the air, before it crashed, he said.

We asked other Egyptian citizens, policemen and passants for directions to the scene. They gave us a number of wrong directions, but we finally found an engineer for the delta light railway. He said he was certain the plane had crashed right on the tracks.

Take Train  
Two doctors, 10 Egyptian firemen and the engineer joined our party. We took a train that moved at snail's pace through the desert, until we finally reached the scene.

A DC-3 plane was sent out from Cairo by TWA. It landed nearby on the desert.

The crash scene was 10 miles from the nearest village or house. Rescuers made stretchers out of steel poles and blankets and carried the bodies to the DC-3.

I flew back to Cairo with 17 of the bodies. We landed at Farouk airport, the landing field which the Constellation pilot was trying to reach when his plane crashed.

### Korea Picture Changing Fast For U. N. Men

Four weeks ago our troops in Korea were taking one another's "Can you hold 'em? Today they are asking: "When do we start the big push?"

United Press dispatch from headquarters in Korea, says that the U. N. troops are taking one another's "Can you hold 'em? Today they are asking: "When do we start the big push?"

Officers who lead the communists probably have one more big offensive left in them. They are confident our troops can stop it and then the time will have arrived to start a big push.

That will be a happy day for Lieut.-Col. Walton H. Walker, U. N. ground force commander. Officers' welfare is his dish, and the grim reality of discipline in holding defensive positions has made him an unhappy man in charge.

"This is the first time in my 40 years of military experience," he said, "when I have had to do anything like this."

Walker is a Texan, raised in the hell-for-leather school of military tactics made famous by Gen. George B. Patton, Jr., in World War II.

So when the American offensive does start, it is likely to move fast. A tremendous amount of material is piling up near the southeast part of our Korean defenses. Much of it is offensive material.

The pattern of the offensive probably will be a combination of the best features of a MacArthur operation and a Patton operation. Gen. Arthur is a great believer in isolating the enemy units and allowing them to die on the spot.

Patton liked nothing better than what soldiers call a "raid" front. He would slash in behind the enemy, cut off his communications, and then drive on, leaving nothing up parties to take care of the isolated units.

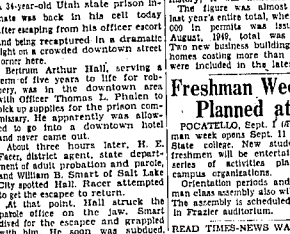

# Koreans Are Singing People, Reporter Finds on His Tours

By H. D. QUINN  
A TOURIST IN Korea, Sept. 1, 1950, you find that Koreans are a singing people. They sing to their hearts' content and they march off to war singing.

Their marching songs were up in the morning. In twilight the streets were filled with singing and strumming of some kind of platoon of small brown men strutting down a loose rock street.

"They sing one song more than all the rest. The class and all of the rest got to bothering me and I refused to go to a Korean training and reception center to find out what it was and what the words meant."

It was a long, hot walk through streets lined with little frame shops and ribboned with wretched humanity. The old women will argue and face the young mothers with bare bosoms and their infants in cloth slings on their backs and patriarchy with exaggerated slovenly hair. The old women will argue with heavy household loads on their heads, trudging along with knees hair bent, their scolding like with little underworn shirts flapping down their hips and nothing below—all were war-driven somewhere, yet going nowhere.

Korean kids grinning by the roadside already have learned to say, "Alo alo" to tourists and to hold out their small hands for favors. Sometimes they add, "Hey, okay" and grin some more.

Along the streets was an occasional crisscross of U. N. armistice signs. The armistice signs were placed to stare tourists and they said: "Hoary, hoary, hoary U. N. forces! These had been signed. 'No more war' and 'American was completely surrounded by Korean boys'."

Announcement of casualty totals would be a return to a policy that was last in operation on Aug. 7 when the department said 2,668 Americans had been killed, wounded or missing in the Korean area.

Since that time, an army spokesman told reporters that the policy was being returned to make sure that casualty figures were not made of value to the enemy.

In recent discussions among the armed services and the defense department, advocates of regular announcements of casualty totals were reported to have advanced two principles:

1. The American public is entitled to be informed regularly about the cost of the war.
2. Failure to do so would give com-

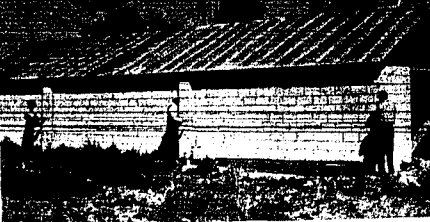
