It is interesting to apply some of Flakoll's statistics of political measurement to the situation which has developed since the Korean war broke out.

Some of Flakoll's basic hypotheses are:

1. Two million voters failed to go to the polls in 1946, even though it was a presidential year, when the vote was ordinarily higher than in mid-term elections.
2. A slight vote helps the Republicans since surveys show that only one of eight persons with Republican sympathies fails to vote while one out of four Democrats normally fails to get to the polls. Hence the heavier the vote, the heavier the Democratic margin.
3. The 1948 elections prove that the farmers elected President Truman while labor, particularly in the industrial northeast, swept the 1948 congressional Republican majority out of office and installed a Democratic house and senate.
4. Statistics prove that 23 to 30 congressmen are elected in each presidential year by virtue of riding the presidential coastlines. This is another way of saying that more people will get out and vote for a President—and incidently the local representative on his ticket—than will bother to vote in a mid-term race.
5. Unemployment and depressed farm prices cause a reaction against the party in power, whereas prosperity favors the election chances of the party in power.
6. A shift in political sides set in against the Democrats after their

Republican campaign to discredit Acheson and Louis Johnson takes hold, the public might participate in that acceptance sacrifice for our initial pool showing in Korea. If, on the other hand, U. S. troops have launched a counter-offensive against the Reds before the election, the public reaction might well favor the Democrats back to with a greater majority. This last will be particularly true if the current Democratic scheme to highlight deficiencies in the Republican "party line" on foreign policy votes is successful.

Before Korea President Truman was promising a "Russian tip" to give Democratic candidates the benefit of a mid-term lift in the presidential campaign. However, he is likely to lose Democratic votes if he so much as votes across the hall for a drink of water.

Clearly in favor of the Democrats is the new war prosperity which should be to full swing by the time the next election is held. Clearly counting on this and putting off such distasteful jobs as increasing controls and hiking tax levels until after the elections are out of the way.

All of this, it is clear, does not tell who is going to win in the November elections. That is something best left to Louis H. Bean, or better yet, to Mr. John Q. Voter who is now making up his own mind.

### New Potato Harvester Makes Magic Valley Debut



This potato harvester working on the Cowling farm southwest of Twin Falls is one of the first machine potato pickers to be tried in Magic Valley.

The test run was arranged by Ross Ward. Another picker was demonstrated near Jerome in 1934.

### Potato Combine, Successful Elsewhere, Tested for Use in Heavier Soils Here

A potato combine which digs the potatoes and loads them by bulk in a truck, two rows at a time, made its Magic Valley debut on a ranch southeast of Twin Falls. Testing the machinery was Ross Ward, Twin Falls farmer.

About 25 persons who had heard of the appearance of the combine at Ward's farm, were on hand for the test run and stood around for several minutes while Ward and his helpers readied the machine for operation.

Then it was towed into the Cowling fields and began to bite into the heavy soil, churning up the green potatoes, clods and what was left of potato vines after whirling was completed.

Ward stood on the combine to operate the machinery as it was towed down the potato rows by the tractor. Standing on the back of the combine were three men who fought a hard battle. Their work was separating the potatoes from the clods and vines which also tumbled into the trough. There the potatoes are picked up by the conveyor which runs to the truck.

Spectators and helpers walked down the rows behind the combine to see how many potatoes were left on the ground and how badly they were bruised and cut by the clanking machine.

Behind the machine the ground was left bare and loose with only an occasional missed potato lying on

the soft ground. Some observers remarked that the combine "missed" no more than the diggers and buckers.

Other potato men picked up spuds to examine the peeled skins. They looked at the clods which pounded the potatoes on the conveyor bars and expressed doubt that the machine is practical in the rich but heavy soil of the valley.

But Ward, who conducted the test, said the combine is "all right" and he demonstrated his faith by purchasing the machine immediately after the tests. He admitted that there are problems to be worked out but feels strongly that mature potatoes will not peel as did the green, thin-skinned tubers.

The clod situation is what worried me," he explained, "and that worked out all right on the test." He pointed out that the test field was dry with hard clods. With experimentation a system of proper irrigation can be worked out to soften the dirt after the vines have been stripped, he felt.

He also pointed out that a considerable amount of potato bruising occurs with the conventional harvesting method of diggers and buckers. The potato combine used in the Idaho Falls and Aberdeen areas for four years, has harvested potatoes there with 20 per cent less bruising than resulted from the hand method, he pointed out.

"We would come to the potato combine in a year or two anyway," Ward explained. "We might as well get started now and work out the problems."

Other farmers respect Ward as a progressive and thorough farmer. He is a farmer whose wheat field yielded more than 99 bushels to the acre this year.

The machine was built by an Idaho Falls concern. The particular type of combine has been in operation in southeastern Idaho about four years.

The machine is pulled by a tractor and, basically, consists of two conveyor troughs with blades on the ends. The blades were beveled into the ground at the right height for the potatoes and the forward motion of the tractor scoops dirt, potatoes and vines up on the conveyor bars.

The dirt and vines are shaken out between the bars of the conveyor as the potatoes are lifted up and back. At the top of the conveyor the potatoes fall into a trough with rubber rollers on the bottom. Sorters stand at this trough and throw out what clods and vines come back that far. The rollers take the potatoes to the conveyor which lifts them up into a truck running alongside.

The two digging conveyors on Ward's combine are spaced for two 24-in and 34-inch rows.
