TUCKER'S NATIONAL WHIRLIGIG

WASHINGTON—Our military weakness in Korea, as the government's unwillingness of American armed forces to even more serious conflict, will be investigated thoroughly by a congressional committee during the next session.

It is an undeniable fact that the present unwillingness of our military to engage in a more serious conflict is the result of a lack of adequate training and equipment.

The demand for a "reexamination" of the national defense plans and policies comes from both sides of the aisle, with Rep. Carl Vinson of Georgia, acknowledged capitol hill authority in these matters and House Armed Services Committee chairman, the most insistent on a congressional cost martial.

MISJUDGED—Moreover, the agency that will have to justify itself will be a group of gentlemen normally immune to the rough treatment awaiting them behind closed doors, where the legislation will not avail them. It is the joint chiefs of staff—Bradley, Collins, Shenandoah, and National Defense University administrators.

These five generals and admirals will have to answer charges that, in the framing of our world policy, they have been negligent in the designing and ordering of weapons, supplies and personnel, in view of the nature and the danger almost every crisis since the end of World War II.

PROPHETIC—The remark of a high-ranking member of Vinson's committee is emblematic of the attitude of the committee. "I want to know," says "General Bradley has to say now about the 'Fancy Duns' of the navy and the 'Fancy Duns' of the army, and the 'Fancy Duns' of the air force, almost every crisis since the end of World War II."

BOMBERS—The unbalanced planning and development of our military forces, particularly our bombers, is a matter of national importance. The bombers are the backbone of our air force, and they must be maintained in a state of readiness.

QUESTION—Adm. Forrest P. Sherman, chief of naval operations, who has been recently re-elected to his post, has been asked to explain the nature of the bomber force. He will have to explain why, until lately and by hindsight, he had to restore the bomber program of our military forces.

SUPPLY—An overall problem will be our supply system. With outbreaks in remote places always afloat, the supply cannot adequately meet its requirements. The supply system must be reorganized to meet the needs of a world war.

### Death Blame Is Placed on Coast's Smog

**LOS ANGELES, Nov. 19 (AP)—**Smog was the cause of the year's worst smog attacks, a California legislative committee heard yesterday. The committee heard testimony from a doctor who said there are more deaths on smoggy days than on clear. Another source may be cause of lung cancer. The committee heard Gordon Larson, head of the county's air pollution control, say that smog has been reduced 35 percent in the last two years. Outside, visibility was only a few blocks in sections and millions of people from their eyes. The weather bureau said smog now will be just as smoggy. The state assembly said water pollution committee was told by Dr. Clarence A. Mills, professor of epidemiology at the University of Cincinnati, that hundreds of excess respiratory deaths are taking place in the large parts of our cities every year. The total yearly cost in such excess deaths was 115 in 1947, 70 in 1948 and 127 in 1949, the scientist said the committee, which has been a consultant. Dr. Harry Goldblatt, of Cedars of Lebanon hospital, Hollywood, in discussing smog, said there are elements that could be present which it breaks in every day, could cause cancer of the lungs.

### Richfield Soldier Tells Experience In Korean Strife

**RICHFIELD, Nov. 19 (AP)—**Mr. and Mrs. Fred Simpson received a letter from their son, Sgt. Parker Simpson, telling some of his experiences in Korea where he was sent in September. Making a 200-mile trip as driver of a heavy army truck, Sergeant Simpson said the dust was so thick they were forced to drive with headlights on and often had to stop to avoid running off the bumpy narrow roads. Very bad weather, 10 below zero, was freezing hands and feet of many boys on the front lines where fighting was scarce. Some soldiers were wearing overcoats and caps belonging to "gooks" in order to keep warm. Simpson told of a narrow escape when his troop came to a bomb-out bridge. They were forcefully ordered away from the district by a lieutenant whom they later credited with saving their lives. Shortly afterward 20 soldiers were killed at that place. Sergeant Simpson is a veteran of World War II. He reenlisted and has been in the army six years.
