Vandal Boxers to Open Season With LSU in Southland

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO, Moscow, Dec. 19.—The University of Idaho boxing squad, co-holders of the national college boxing crown and two-times Pacific coast intercollegiate champions, will open their season Dec. 28 at New Orleans against Louisiana State University in a feature of Sugar bowl week.

The Vandal boxing squad of eight boxers along with Coach Frank Young will fly to New Orleans for the southland. The squad will arrive in New Orleans on the morning of Dec. 26, and will leave there Jan. 2 for the return air jaunt.

Coach Young said the following will make the trip: Frankie Echevarria, Junior, 125-pounder from Blackfoot; Bert Tovey, senior, 130, Malad; Norm Walker, senior, 135, Wallace; Bud Lawson, Junior, 145, Tekoa; Wash. Lee Walker, senior, 155, Wallace; Earl King, Junior, 165, Payette; Larry Meyer, sophomore, 175, Porterville; and Coach Young, senior, heavyweight, Caldwell.

This squad is captained by Walker, who in 1949 won the Pacific coast and national individual 145-pound title, and in 1950 was the national 145-pound champion. This year Walker has moved up into the 165-pound class and took the championship as he did at the lighter weight.

The Vandals will miss such all-around fighters as Herb Carlson, three times national champion, and four times Idaho champion at light weight. Other notable fighters are Jerome, 175; and Don Ellis, heavyweight, all by graduation. Despite these losses, Coach Young does not feel dependent about Idaho's chances of finishing high among the college boxers this year.

Last year the Vandals won several dual meets, one dropping a 5 to 3 decision to the University of Washington. The Pacific coast intercollegiate tournament and tied with Gonzaga of Oregon for the national championship. In the tournament, Carlson was named as the outstanding college boxer of the nation.

The Vandals meet the Louisiana State will be the second time the two institutions have met in the Pacific coast. The Vandals made the trip in 1940 and drew with the southern school, 2-1.

Tommy Henrich Quits as Player To Join Yanks in Coaching Job

NEW YORK, Dec. 19 (AP)—Tommy Henrich, a member of New York Yankees since 1937 and one of the game's most feared hitters, decided to hang up his glove today rather than play on an injured knee. He accepted a job on the coaching staff of the world champions.

Tommy, known as "Old Reliable" for his timely hitting and slick play in the right field and at first base, played very little the past season and was taken off the eligible list for the world series between the Yankees and the Phillies.

The knee, injured in a spring, pained him severely each time he had to make a quick turn or stop. Doctors were sure only a half-hope would afford any real improvement.

So at 31, the old Madison Co. boy has chosen to call it a career. He will be the fourth man on Manager Casey Stengel's coaching staff.

Had he wished, Henrich could have had the job of managing the Yankees' Kansas City club. He was named to the job by the American association. He preferred, however, to manage the Yankees. He has been an important cog in every Yankee pennant winner since 1937. He received a \$25,000 bonus for signing with the Yanks after Coach-manager Landis took him away from Cleveland in '37 and declared him free agent.

His highest batting mark in a full season with the Yanks was .200 in 1944, but he dented .207 in another year and always was good for a solid .200 or thereabout, with plenty of extra bases thrown in. No opposing pitcher tried to see him when they were on base.

Frank (Glaty) O'Doul, manager of the San Francisco Seals, still holds the National League record for most hits in a season—254 in 1929.

Area's Skiers May Organize Defense Force

SEATTLE, Dec. 19 (AP)—Pacific Northwest skiers have started a movement to organize the 6,000 skiers in this region as a potential mountain guerrilla force in case of invasion by an enemy.

The movement is headed by Buster Campbell, University of Washington ski coach and president of the Pacific Northwest Ski association. He said plans call for training the skiers to guard mountain passes, hydro-electric projects, domestic water supplies, power lines and communication systems as well as carry on guerrilla warfare.

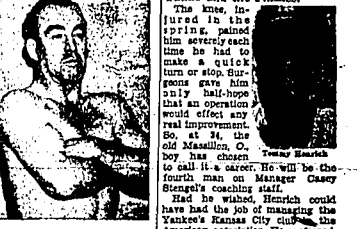
The plan, still in its drawing-board stages, has been submitted to federal civil defense authorities for approval.

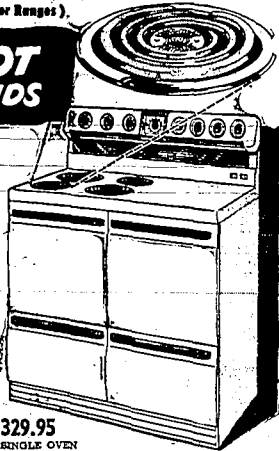

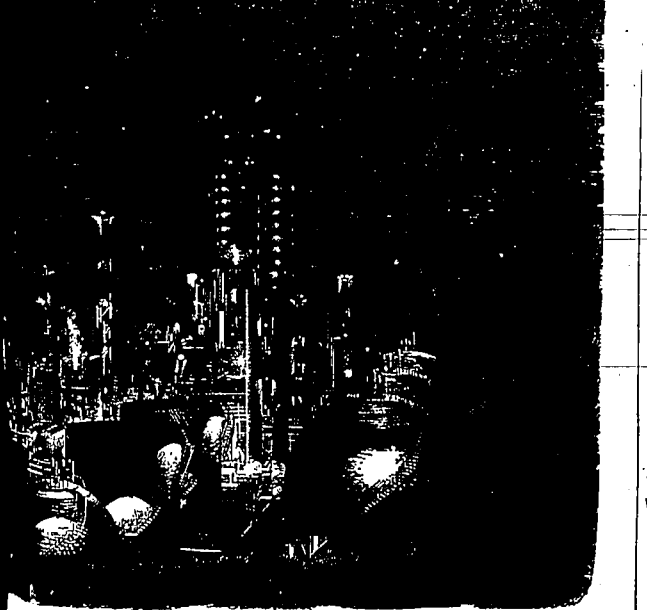

President Roosevelt said today the peak of the latest European war scare has passed.

With the United States getting on its feet, he said, the European army showed signs of actuality, there is a feeling that general warfare will not come for a while yet.

The crisis developed faster than expected, finding the world unprepared for an atomic war which full-scale hostilities would develop quickly.

Therefore, that period this Christmas might be described as "the truce of the atom bomb."

Mysterious Sphere Found in New Mexico Stumps Scientists

ALBUQUERQUE, N. M., Dec. 11.—The University of New Mexico Monday disclosed that a mysterious 18-inch sphere was found by deer hunters south of here nearly a month ago and still has not been identified.

The object, with its accessories, has the appearance of a meteorite. Dr. Elmer Latta, head of the Institute of Meteoritics at the university, cannot explain the find. Nor can numerous other agencies who have inspected it.

The sphere came to Dr. Latta in connection with his recent investigation of fibrous and metallic materials. In the final case the sphere—weighing 7 pounds 2 ounces—was an object resembling a large flower pot built of plastic impregnated with nylon fibers; a cheap alarm clock equipped with an expensive micro switch, and three packages of photographic film used in nuclear research.

The materials are seemingly American-made. The film is stamped with the name of a London, England, firm but is also stamped by an American.

General Cate commented: "The marine needs men like Technical Sergeant Robert J. Ward."

Although the state steel mill manufacturer warned no steel will be shipped if the federal government declines it, he says it more than the state.

An action in involuntary bankruptcy was brought against Mrs. Palmer by Belle A. Hoelsten and Walter H. Hayes, Los Rios, and J. E. Van Dusen, Jr., all of Boise.

They claimed in their petition that Mrs. Palmer owed Ada McCuffin, \$7,227; Belle Hoelsten, \$2,000; and J. E. Van Dusen, \$2,000, on a series of promissory notes.
