# IDAHO MAY GET A BREAK

Indications are that the forthcoming session of the state legislature will concern itself with things other than the usual legislative wrangling over liquor, slot machines and pari-mutuel betting.

Moreover, it is becoming increasingly apparent that Gov. Elmer L. Jordan intends to offer more than just a constructive executive leadership than has come out of the governor's office for a number of years.

It should be significant that since his election Mr. Jordan has been spending most of his time making the rounds of state institutions and familiarizing himself generally with the administration of the state's affairs.

When he takes office he will be able to work on a number of things Idaho has been needing for years. Instead of hitting the job "cold" and taking two or three months to feel his way, our new governor should be able to exert a strong influence on the new legislature.

As Mr. Jordan pointed out in his campaign, there still remains a serious need for reorganization of our state government.

The legislature last session shadow-boxed with this problem following an exhaustive survey of the department by impartial investigators, nothing of any consequence resulted. What was supposed to be a reorganization amounted to nothing more than the same exercises being given different titles with increases in salary.

For weeks the new governor has been consulting with legislative committees in working out proposed plans for an effective reorganization of our state government.

When the legislature convenes a comprehensive program should be ready for the legislators' consideration. With proper support from the general public there is reason to believe a genuine reorganization of the highway department will result.

No doubt there will be considerable opposition by some of the old wheel horses of both political parties because for years the highway department has been the primary target for political patronage. It has been loaded down with hundreds of political hacks who have had no qualifications whatsoever for highway work, particularly in the operation of expensive road maintenance equipment.

Law enforcement is another matter on which Mr. Jordan has expressed himself clearly and that this department also will be reorganized on a more efficient basis. Even some of the state policemen themselves are in favor of having the department set up on a merit system.

It is to be hoped that the highway department is organized efficiently, additional patrolmen should be added to make state law enforcement more effective.

The state's system of leasing derelict liquor licenses is another matter which has a real purpose is concerned other than collecting the fees. That is another problem which cries for attention and there is strong likelihood that this department will be reorganized on a more efficient basis.

Idaho's laws dealing with juveniles also are seriously in need of revision.

Should our new governor and the new legislature bring about workable solutions to all these major problems, it could easily prove to be the most effective combination this state has seen in many years.

### Price Orders Are Clarified By Questions

WASHINGTON, Dec. 20 (AP)—Here are some questions and answers about the government's price order program.

**Q. Are businessmen permitted to keep a lid on the program?**  
 A. No. The program for the moment, is entirely "voluntary" and merely puts them on their honor to keep prices down.

**Q. What is considered a "fair price"?**  
 A. Generally those that prevailed on Dec. 1. In some cases, businessmen are being asked to cancel price increases made since the Korean war began.

**Q. Are there any standards for deciding where prices should be pegged?**  
 A. Yes. A manufacturer, for example, could not raise his prices above the Dec. 1 level if his net profit before taxes was equal to or above his average profit from 1936 through 1940.

**Q. Are about wholesale and retail dealers?**  
 A. They were asked to keep their margins at the same percentage between their costs and selling prices—to the same level prevailing last June if their net profits before taxes are equal to or bigger than the 1940-41 average.

**Q. Are any price reductions expected?**  
 A. The government wants business to cancel price increases effective since last Dec. 1. If they fail to meet the profit test, it also wants wholesale and retail dealers to roll back any increases that resulted from higher markups since start of the Korean war.

**Q. What happens if a businessman ignores the government's standards and boots prices anyway?**  
 A. Price Administrator Michael V. D'Elia has warned that anyone who raises prices without justification can expect the government to order a mandatory rollback "at the earliest feasible time."

**Q. What happens if the voluntary system fails to keep prices in check?**  
 A. D'Elia's agency will start putting on compulsory controls as fast as it gets the start to enforce them.

**Q. Are farmers blanketed under the voluntary program?**  
 A. Not for the moment. Most farm products are exempt now because they are selling below parity levels.

**Q. Are food prices exempt?**  
 A. No. All food sold at wholesale or retail are included in the program.

In the middle of the Christmas rush hours an attractive, fashionably dressed woman stepped up to a cashier's window in the Pasadena First National and Savings bank, laid down four \$10 bills, and asked for a fifty-dollar bill.

The cashier, who told her the lady was \$10 short.

The cashier said she told her purse, found another \$10 and said the "lady" will get a \$100 bill while she was at it.

The cashier obligingly passed the \$100 bill across the counter and tucked in the woman's five \$10 bills and the bank's \$50.

Bank officials pondered their mathematicians and police were notified.

The cashier is still scratching his head.

### Living Costs Heading for New Record

WASHINGTON, Dec. 20 (AP)—The administrative call Tuesday for a voluntary price freeze came amid indications that the cost-of-living index may hit its highest point in all-time peak.

Latest government figures showed that the cost-of-living index hit a new record high for the week ending Tuesday, Dec. 12.

The U. S. Bureau of labor statistics, which issued the figures, said the Dec. 12 index marked an advance of 0.4 per cent and was the third straight week in which a record had been set.

The advance sent the wholesale price index to 173.4 per cent of the "normal" 1926 level and was 10.2 per cent higher than on June 20, five days before the outbreak of the Korean war.

### Higher Prices Seen

It would appear that if the government later decides to roll back prices to Dec. 1 levels under mandatory controls, it will be taken if necessary—prices will still be considerably higher than before the Korean war began.

Latest available figures on the cost-of-living index—now to be confused with the wholesale price index—show that all-around living costs rose to a new record high in mid-October with low signs of tapering off since then.

The C-I index, reflecting Oct. 15 prices, hit 174.8 per cent of the 1926-29 price average which is taken as normal. That record compared with the previous all-time high of 172.5 set in August-September, 1945.

### Widow of Famed Editor Dies at 81

EMPORIA, Kan., Dec. 20 (AP)—Mrs. Bessie White, widow of the nation's most renowned "country editor," died in her sleep yesterday after a brief illness. She was 81.

Mrs. White, who had been in poor health, had not appeared in critical condition when admitted to an Emporia hospital with influenza.

Mrs. White, who aided her late husband actively in development of the Emporia Gazette, had been partially incapacitated since fracturing a hip in a fall in July, 1945.

Mrs. White became co-owner of the Gazette with her son in 1944 when her editor-husband died. A year ago, the son, William E. White, became sole owner in a reorganization move.

### 20 Located Dead In Airline Wreck

BOMBAY, India, Dec. 20 (AP)—Searchers last night found the wreckage of an Air India plane missing in southern India since last Wednesday.

All 20 passengers and crewmen were dead. They included Prof. Abraham Wald, director of mathematics at Columbia university, and his wife.

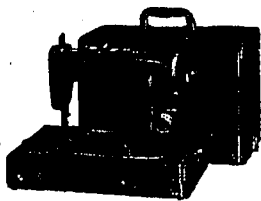

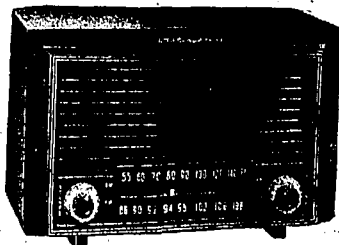

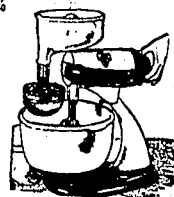

NEW YORK, Dec. 20 (AP)—The 10-member Chinese communist delegation to the United Nations spent money like bloated capitalists during their 26-day visit.

Before Gen. Wu Hsiang-chuan and his colleagues flew home to Peking yesterday, they loaded their luggage with 2,077 pounds of luxuries bought in Manhattan's swanky shops.

"It was just like an English aristocrat's custom men at Idlewild airport said of the fashionably dressed Chinese.

They were a far different looking seven men and two women than the group which arrived last month. At that time, the men wore shabby black coats and the women wore furs that had seen far better days. 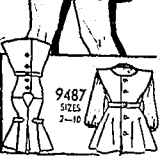

A hearing will be held in Washington on Feb. 1 by Examiner F. Merritt Hubell. All airlines serving the west-coast will participate. Originally, the hearing was scheduled for Jan. 5, but it is being postponed to give west coast cities more time to prepare economic data.

Following the fare pattern established by railroads, airlines now charge the same fares between Chicago, west coast cities and also between the west coast cities and those east of Chicago.

It is possible for a passenger to fly from Chicago to San Francisco, with a stopover of several days in Los Angeles, for the same fare that would apply from Chicago to San Francisco.

Opinions Asked  
The board a year ago asked all airlines to present their views on the "common fare" practice. It now is trying to determine:  
1. Whether the common fares should continue, regardless of distance.  
2. How much circuitry should be allowed.  
3. Should stopovers be restricted.  
The board's public opinion takes the position that the proper method of fixing fares should be on the basis of total mileage and fares between intermediate points.
