TOKYO, Feb. 13 (AP)—Chinese communists shifted the direction of their massive attack in central Korea today and north and east. Mortar fire was falling inside the city. Other Chinese forces surrounded Chipyong and launched an attack on the town. Tanks and self-propelled guns pounded Chipyong from the southwest while artillery or mortars were firing from the northeast. Other attacks came from the north and east. Mortar fire was falling inside the city. Gen. Douglas MacArthur visited the western front and warned on his return to Tokyo that the enemy still has plenty of manpower and supplies. The first red onslaught dented allied lines as much as 10 miles and was met by a 1000-foot force of the road center of Hwangju 10 miles north of Wonyu and 40 miles south of Seoul.

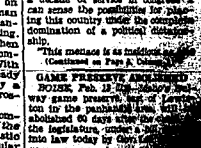

BOISE, Feb. 13 (UP)—The Idaho Education association broke its silence today on the legislative controversy over state aid to education.

In its first official comment on Gov. Len Jordan's recommendations for economy in the state government, the IEA went on record as favoring "at least a 10 per cent increase in the minimum program."

John M. Booth, executive secretary of the IEA, released the group's statement outlining its stand on the education issue. Booth said the IEA represented 4,500 teachers in Idaho schools and educational institutions.

"Since the present level of equalization was established by law in 1947, the costs of goods and services required for schools has sharply increased, but school revenues have remained relatively unchanged," the statement said.
