**Change Slated In Short-Haul Mail Carrying**

WASHINGTON, Feb. 20 (AP)—The postoffice department has announced plans for making a major shift of short-haul mail from the railroads to highway trucks, operating under contract.

Assistant Postmaster General John M. Redding told a news conference the diversion program will begin within the next few weeks. He said it involves "the most important change in basic postal transportation since air mail."

Redding said the government pays out about \$100,000,000 a year in transportation charges for short-distance mail delivery—that is over distances of 200 miles or less. This is the type of mail now proposed for diversion to the highways.

Redding declined to say how much of the total short-distance tonnage will be given to trucks under competitive bidding, but indicated that a substantial portion of it eventually.

Redding said the pending portion of the railroads before the interstate commerce commission for a 23 per cent increase in mail pay rates over 1947 levels was one factor in the decision to shift short-haul mail.

Also involved, he said, is the increasing number of railroad branch line abandonments.

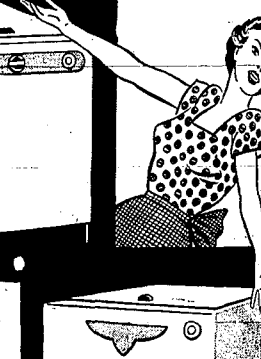



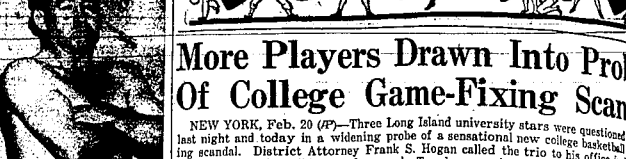

### Most of State Is Blanketed In Radio Net

BOISE, Feb. 20 (AP)—About 80 per cent of this state is blanketed now by the Idaho highway department's new two-way radio system.

The department said it has completed installation and is operating two more big transmitters in the two Idaho highway districts.

The new, 250-watt transmitters are installed at Pocatello, Shoshone, Boise, Lewiston and Coeur d'Alene. A 50-watt transmitter is operating at Idaho Falls.

To complete the network, eight mobile, two-way sets are operating in each of the six highway districts. The mobile receiving and transmitting sets ordinarily are mounted in pickups or other light trucks.

The radio system already has proved its worth many times, the department said. It is particularly valuable in equipment and maintenance work, snow removal and maintenance work. The network also is used to round up a daily report on highway conditions throughout the state.
