REGISTERING FIREARMS

It is not surprising that a civilian defense ill now pending in the Idaho state legislature tould meet with some opposition. It is time for the United States and the west to make up their minds more clearly about what they will do to defend Yugoslavia, Greece, Turkey and Iran Irom communist
