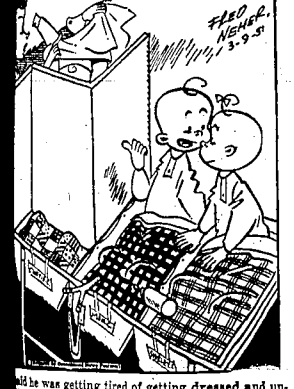

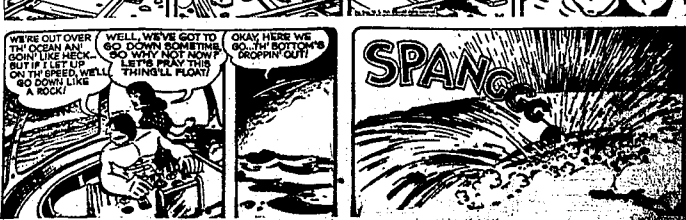
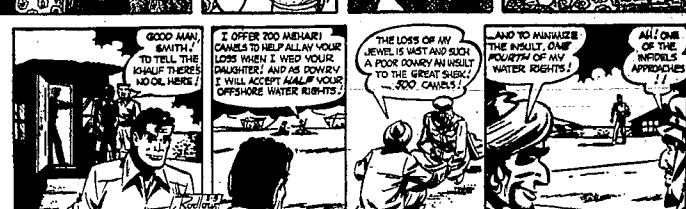

milk it sold to the federal government.  
Cronshaw also reviewed governmental actions concerning butter and competitive products as by the excise and their use by the armed forces. He wanted a proposal to lower inspection standards for grade A milk and other products and how that would harm the reputation for quality established for this state's dairy products.  
Describes Milk Surplus  
Turning to marketing conditions, he described a surplus of milk. Answering a previous question from the floor he warned that going into retail sales of grade A milk might not prove as profitable as it appears on the surface. He also warned of a threat to the dairy industry through the use of non-dairy cream in evaporated milk and ice cream.  
Counsellor also reviewed conditions in Texas, the southeast portion of the United States and California, all market outlets for this area's products. He said California milk production is dropping because of increased acreages of cotton. Water supply limitations may hold down population and the market in California, he declared.  
Site of Cooperative  
"Cooperatives have to stick together," he told the dairymen, "whatever we do collectively is bound to succeed." He said the Jerome Cooperative Creamery is considered one of the largest in the western area and is fourth largest in the Challenge system, itself the second largest milk distributor in Los Angeles.  
Site and Impact of the Jerome Creamery operations were brought out in a figure-studded preliminary report by Roy D. Smith, general manager at Jerome. His complete report will be given at the general meeting March 17 at Jerome.  
Gains Listed  
He said the creamery sold \$3,000,000 worth of products last year and handled 90,000,000 pounds of milk. His preliminary report also noted gains in various other creamery activities. He also discussed butter and competitive products.  
Both Smith and the manager of the Twin Falls plant, Lyons Smith, stressed the merchandising help association members can give by insisting the store they patronize give Challenge products advantageous display and promotion.  
Quality Stressed  
"The general manager said the creamery is stressing quality and declared, "It's paying off." He also

### GOP Tallies Absence List On President

WASHINGTON, March 9 (AP)—The Republican national committee is circulating without comment a "record of the absences" from Washington of President Truman since Jan. 1, 1934.  
It showed Mr. Truman was away 66 days, exclusive of his current 29-day trip to Key West, Fla., on various business speaking and other journeys, and another 26 days' cruises in nearby waters, mostly week-end outings.  
Includes 29-Day Stay  
The 66 days included what the committee called the President's "vacation" at Key West a year ago which lasted 29 days. The White House insists the President also puts in a lot of work in Florida besides relaxing in the sun.  
The committee said the record was prepared by its research division at the request of Senator Watkins, R., Mich. It distributed it also for the "information of correspondents."  
Intent Not Reported  
Senator Watkins' office said the senator had not had a chance to read it and it was not known what he intended to do with it.  
Last Tuesday, Senator Knowland, R., Calif., in a senate speech, said the President should return from his Florida vacation and clean house. He alluded to several recent investigations now going on, including that into RFC lending operations.
