BOISE, April 24 (AP)—Mrs. Maude McCoy, Twin Falls, Great state vice chairman of the MacArthur case, said today that the emotional incident "must lead to some clear decision on our course in Korea."

Addressing the American Legion, the public woman's club here last night, Mrs. McCoy said the emotional incident given Gen. Douglas MacArthur emerged through the "emotional" incident in Korea "months ago as a symbol of hope."
