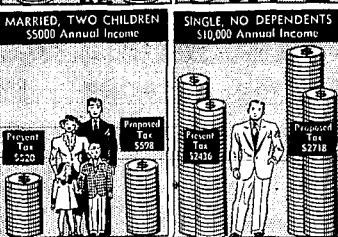
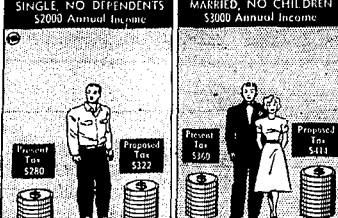

### Northwest Milling, Shipping May Get Boost From Wheat Shipments to India

WASHINGTON, May 23 (Special)—Northwest shipping and milling may get a boost out of the business by emergency aid bill passed by the senate last week.

Although a lot of obstacles remain actual congressional approval and actual 2,000,000 tons of wheat, agricultural and commercial department officials feel that a big share of the cargo will move from Pacific ports.

On the other hand, the proposed bill—there is little certainty.

Gong. Thos. C. Tolson, Jr., Wash., said he had appeared before congressional committees in the early stages of the aid movement to ask that part of any wheat sent as gift should be in the form of flour.

With the change from wheat to flour, however, it will be hard to make definite specifications.

But legislators and administration officials think at least part of the grain will have to go through western mills now operating at only 60 per cent of capacity. This is because India lacks mills and shipping space will be tight.

Commonwealth Corp. president said that there is no exact precedent for the proposed Indian grain aid although they said some flour was included in the Yugoslavian emergency shipments.

In the case of current U.S. grain movement, at least 12 1/2 per cent is flour.

As for space, commodity credit says most coast grain shipments hit record highs in April and are expected to continue at peak levels.

To handle additional cargoes, the national shipping administration may have to pull vessels out of storage.

India has been making little publicized purchases of American wheat during the last six months and next month is to move 100,000 tons, of which 40,000 will be shipped from western ports. Even with space available, it is estimated that only a major amount of the new loan grain under advantageous rates established by the national shipping authority last week.

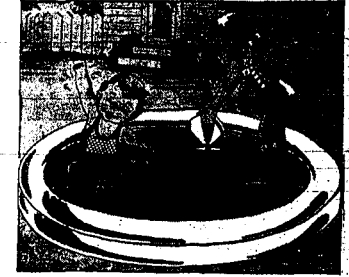

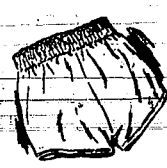

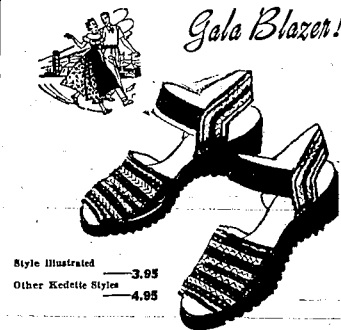
