

UMT SEEMS ASSURED

It took a long, long time, but at leat we are on the road to schlering universal military training. Although some 1814-year-olds (and some parents) may disagree, that's the most important news in the new manpower draft bill just signed by President Truman. To be sure, a lot has to happen before UMT becomes an actuality. First off, a five-member national security training committee will have to get to work and spell out the details of operation. The committee has to make its report to congress some time within the next four months, and it has to have the endorsement of the secretary of defense.

After that, the armed services committees of each house will have 48 more days to mul over the details. Then comes the debate on the floor, As has happened before, of course, the argument could go on forever without getting anywhere. But Senator Russell, chairman of the armed services committee, promises action will be speedy once the supporting legislation needed for UMT is ready. The experts in Washington seem to think UMT will take a back seat until the Korean war is over, an observation which could mean anything, since nobody knows what the next move in Korea will be.






