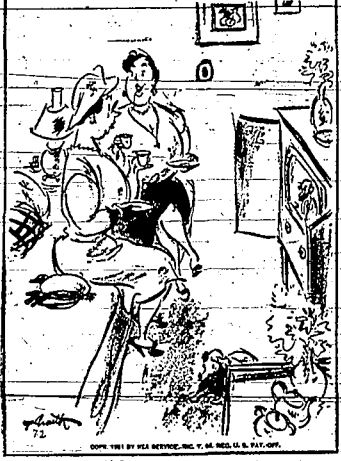

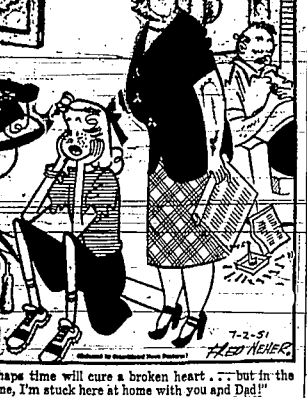

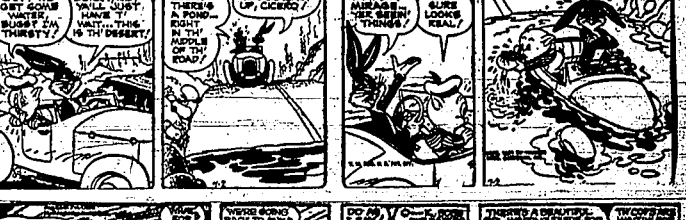

### Veteran of War in Korea Says Blood, Plasma Saved Soldiers

Plasma and whole blood donated by civilians undoubtedly are responsible for saving many lives in Korea, said Capt. Dewey L. Buswell, medical advisor to the administrative officer, while visiting his parents, Mr. and Mrs. C. F. Buswell, 203 Sixth Avenue east. He served almost a year with the second division in Korea.

When informed that the Red Cross bloodmobile will be at the Legion hall in Twin Falls Tuesday to receive donations, Captain Buswell said he had no idea of the great number of lives saved by blood plasma, but opined it is essential for those who need it, although a comparatively small number of wounds require it.

Captain Buswell said plasma is always available at battalion aid stations, usually about one and one-half miles from the battlefield, and at collecting stations. Plasma is not used any "older" to the front or on the battlefield because there is no way to carry or store it.

Capt. Buswell was squad officer in a medical company with the ninth infantry regiment in Korea. He went overseas with the second division last July. This is his second tour of overseas duty.

Captain Buswell entered the army in January, 1942, at an enlisted man's camp.
