

Beef prices will som and a serious beef abortage will develop if controls are relaxed in any way, according to the department of agriculture's latest survey of cattle on feed, it covers the 1f corn-belt states from Ohio to South Takenta, Nebrusha and Kamsar, and shows nine per cent fewer cattle on feed than a year ago.

The American Meat Institute, which is the

packers' trade association, translates this into 117,000,000 pounds less beef in the next 30 to 90 days, than in the same period of 1950. This is about one pound less per adult, but that's enough of a shortage to encourage a black market, without livestock daughtering

quotas.

There are still more cattle on ranges than
ever before, but feed-lot operators haven't
bought them for conditioning and later
marketing. The threat of price controls and
roll-backs is blamed for this situation.
