Billions Levy To Avoid Deficit

WASHINGTON, Aug. 15 (UP)—Staff experts of the house-keeping committee on the economic report said today a \$10-billion bill is necessary to keep the nation on a pay-as-you-go basis and avoid a budget deficit during fiscal 1952.

Staff economists also said any additional taxes above the \$10-billion bill passed by the house will have to come from income groups making from \$3,000 to \$10,000 a year.
