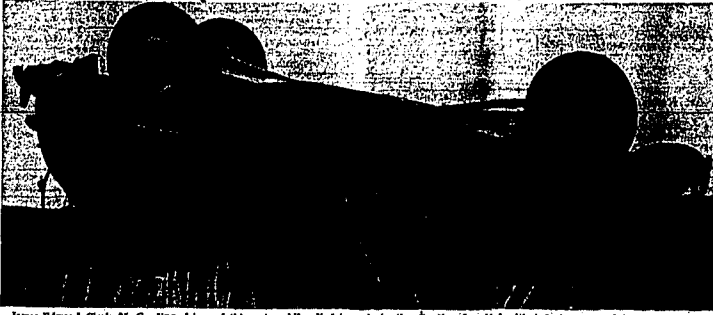

The U. S. internal revenue bureau is an agency which was designed originally to collect \$5,000,000 in tax for the government annually. But today it finds itself in the business of collecting \$3,000,000,000.

How has the bureau done the strain of a 10-fold increase in its operations?

Apparently not very well. In fact, the evidence of corruption now being amassed in many parts of the country. In New York, Boston, Washington, St. Louis, San Francisco and other cities, investigations are under way. Much already has been uncovered, and more progress will be made within the month when special house ways and means subcommittee starts delving into the bureau's activities.

It's a sad story of collectors taking bribes, revenue agents extorting money, tax cases being settled through political influence, and a whole lot of other things.

With moral laxity in and out of government a dangerously common affair these days, perhaps we should not be surprised that it has, in fact, become a vulnerable agency as a tax bureau. Billions are a great temptation.

But any sound inquiry into the bureau's operations should not stop with the uncovering of sensational criminal scandals. This is the moment for sober review of all phases of bureau policy and practice.

The agency is fast young, with branches everywhere. Is Washington's authority over this organization too great or too little? How uniformly are the tax laws applied from one district to the next? Is bureau personnel adequately paid or is it recruited?

It's a question especially since the top posts in the internal revenue bureau are seldom filled on merit. They are political plums, highly prized.

The Hoover commission, in its exhaustive statement of investigation, recommended that all officials of the bureau be appointed from the career service, with no senate confirmation involved.

Congress has not seen fit to act on this recommendation for evident reasons. And so a system inherently weak is being perpetuated.

Indeed, the pressures upon the system have mounted as government grew and the tax take soared to unprecedented levels. More and more, bureau workers have been tempted by taxpayers to comply at variance.

Now if there is one thing an average taxpayer dreads more than hearing the government is wasting his money, it's learning that some of his fellow men aren't sharing the burden the way they should.

Consequently, the public isn't likely to be as complacent about revenue bureau shenanigans as it seems to be toward laxity in other departments. People will want action when they hear of such things.

 Here's a dish that's both hearty and sweet enough to serve as salad or dessert. Offer it to some of the girls when they're coming over for the bridge or canasta. If you want to please the pineapple salad with something hot, you might serve French onion soup (this comes next to pineapple salad) to complete the menu as hot and cold tea or coffee.  
 If you want something simpler, serve a mix-your-own fruit salad. To make it just put one and also less oranges and apple slices of fresh (fresh or canned). Press up the salad by adding banana with a fork and then slicing them and then these with walnuts. Add whatever berries are available in your market, or use melon balls. Serve two drinks per person for the dietlers and a rich one for those who are not watching their weight.

**Mix-your-own fruit salad**  
 Ingredients: 2 envelopes unflavored gelatin, 2 cups 1% or 2% crushed pineapple (reserve 2 tablespoons for garnish), 1 pint cottage cheese, 1/2 cup granulated sugar, 1 cup chopped walnut meats, 1 green pepper (chopped), 1/2 cup raisins, 1/2 cup cranberries, 1/2 cup pineapple (chopped), 1/2 pint heavy cream.  
 Method: Add gelatin to syrup drained from canned pineapple (about 1/2 cup), in heatproof measuring cup. Mix 2 minutes for gelatin to soften, then set in small pan of hot water; heat until gelatin is dissolved. Mix drained pineapple, cottage cheese, mayonnaise, sugar, walnuts, green pepper, pimiento and raisins. Add gelatin-syrup mixture and cream and fold in. Pour into a glass or aluminum loaf pan (9 1/2 x 10 inches x 5 inches) on oiled paper. Individual molds, chill in refrigerator several hours or until set, or overnight. Garnish with fresh fruit and pimiento around the loaf; crush pineapple in green pepper ring and use as garnish. Chill in refrigerator on crisp lettuce. Pass mayonnaise. If you like, makes 12 servings.
