### Board Grants Sale of Idaho Land; Timber

BOISE, Sept. 11 (AP)—The state land board has approved for sale more than 4,000,000 bushels of state-owned timber plus 2,748 acres of land.

The board returned two timber sale applications—120 acres in Bonner county and 800 acres in Shoshone county—because the timber was immature and the cutting would damage future logging.

Land sale applications approved included: 120 acres in Latah county; 115 acres in Ada county; 80 acres in Blaine county; 260 in Conda county; 840 in Blaine county; 700 in Blaine county; and 133 acres in Teton county.

**Sale Refused**  
The board refused the application of a tract in Latah county and 40 acres in Blaine county. Mineral leases approved include 40 acres in Blaine county for quartz mining to A. A. Anderson; 200 acres of oil and gas lease of 480 acres in Long Beach, Calif.; two sections in Blaine county for phosphate to R. Simpson, Boise; and 640 acres for phosphate in Blaine county to Ruby Simpson, Boise.

**Gravel Lease OK'd**  
The board also granted lease to Dundick, Inc., Lewiston, to remove gravel from 300 feet of the bed of the Clearwater river above the new bridge near Lewiston. The dredging is to be under strict supervision of the land department. Commissioner Edward Woolley said.

In other business, the board granted two section rights, one on 23 acres in Idaho county for a public road to Prairie Lumber Co., Grangeville, and the second on 150 acres in Oneida county to Utah Power and Light company for a power line.

The board authorized Commissioner E. F. Haworth, department chief, to make investments, to bid on two bonds, one of \$25,000 in Clearwater county and one of \$67,000 in Teton county.

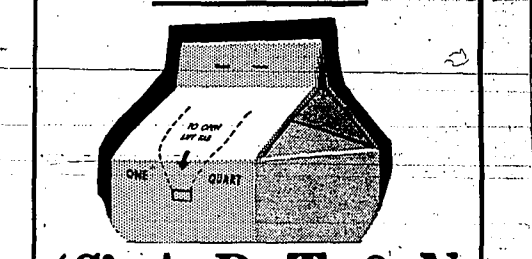

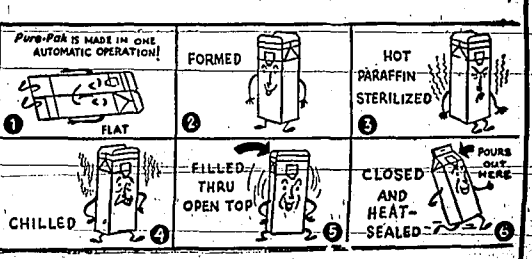

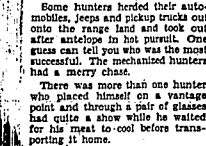

### Officials View Weed Control Achievements

BURLEY, Sept. 11—Gov. Len Jordan, State Land Commissioner Ed Woodley, Secretary of State De Masters, Superintendent of Schools A. P. Jones and State Auditor N. P. Tolson, all members of the state land board, made an inspection Sunday of the halogeton research project, at a site located with the weed in the Hall river and Oakley areas in connection with inspection of state lands in other counties.

The board was briefed by Howard Morton and George Zappettini on the research program being made by the University of Idaho's halogeton research team. Members were shown plots treated with various materials and were taken to a field of wheat grass seedlings where experimental work is being conducted. These seedlings were made by the bureau of land management in 1948 and 1949.

Steps were made on sections of land where the dominant vegetation was shadeless. This vegetation has been attacked by a moth which has all but wiped out the shadeless. With eradication of the shadeless, the area is left barren, representing conditions favorable for invasion by halogeton.

### Modern Suits Of Armor Due For U. S. GI's

WASHINGTON, Sept. 11 (AP)—Lightweight plastic armor, the modern version of "suits of armor" which protected medieval knights, soon will be issued to some American troops fighting in Korea.

The army also announced a new lightweight plastic helmet has been developed to replace the present one.

The armored clothing probably will be issued first to previously designated filter bearers who are in the thick of battle to rescue wounded men.

Two types of body armor have been developed. One is a rigid type made of several laminated layers of glass fiber and plastic. The other is made of several layers of nylon fabric pressed together and is more flexible.

The flexible type is adequate for protection against shell fragments and small arms fire which have lost most of their velocity. Studies showed most wounds are caused by this type of fire.

The rigid type, called the Dorn

jacket, has stopped a .45 caliber bullet at pointblank range, the army said.
