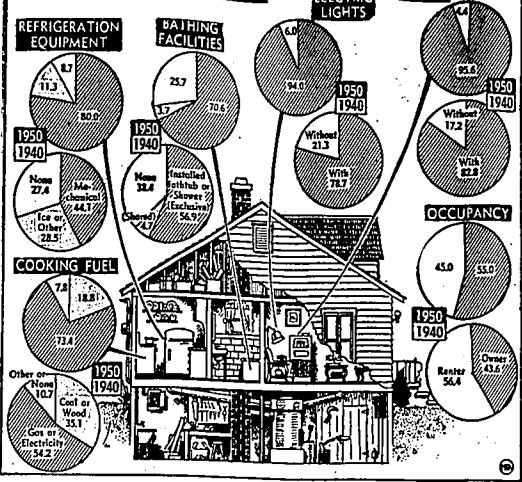

POCAATELLO, Sept. 2 (AP)—Operation of the class C Pioneer league in 1952 was assured today—but it will be at least three weeks before the future complexion of the circuit is determined.

When they adjourned, President J. P. Halliwell declared flatly: "The directors were unanimous that the league will operate next year. Some meetings had been held, but it is obvious that many directors would be inclined to believe that the circuit might have trouble continuing because of the short season, increased operating costs, attendance drop and franchise difficulties at Twin Falls and Pocatello."

The St. Louis Cardinals are dropping their own bid to purchase the Pocatello franchise to raise \$150,000 to provide local ownership.
