



Newspapers also have their annual "week" id this year its significance takes on more eaning than ever before in this country's

history.

Ours is one of the few remaining countries in the world in which the people are guaranteed the protection of a free press, but as never before, we must be on our guard to

cep it free.

To assume that it will over remain the trong bulwark in our democracy would be a relous mistake. We already have many minous aigns to give us due warning that he same forces which destroyed the free ress of many other countries are at work.

Editor & Publisher, leading trade journal for the newspiper Industry, recently called attention to developments in various parts of the country, which serve as examples of actions which "are obviously detrimentarito the unfettered operation of the press."

In Louisians, the state so well known for its rotten politics, five newspapermen are under indictment on charges of "defaming somblers and public officials." It remains to be seen whether the gamblers in Louisians, with all the influence they can bring to be accepted in gagging the newspapers, will be successful in gagging the newspapers. In Maryland, two weekly editors were barred from town council sessions and, in Wisconsin, a school board was urged by a member to "go on record" as being opposed to having the press represented at its meetings.
