**Effect Varied By Change in Excise Levies**  
 WASHINGTON, Oct. 22 (AP)—You'll pay more under the new tax law which Congress passed last week before the presidential election in the national campaign than you will pay under the old law.

Some things—roller skates and baby oil, for instance—will be taxed less. Generally speaking, however, federal excise taxes will be raised on the new law.

The new excise tax rates will go into effect Nov. 1. Here are some of the main changes:

Liquor—Up from 80 to 105.50 per gallon—or 30 cents a fifth on 100 proof.

Beer—Up from 85 to 90 per barrel.

Wine—Now 15 cents, 60 cents, or 82 per gallon, depending on alcoholic content, would be raised to 17 cents, 67 cents, and 82.25.

Cigarettes—Up from 23.50 to 44 per 1,000, or from 7 cents to 8 cents per pack.

Chewing and smoking tobacco and snuff—Cut from 18 to 10 cents per pound.

Passenger cars—Up from 7 to 10 per cent of manufacturer's price. This applies to new cars only.

Gasoline—Up from 1 1/2 cents to 2 cents per gallon.

Diesel fuel—Not now taxed; will be taxed at 2 cents per gallon.

Electric bills—Now 3 1/2 per cent; repealed.

Electric, gas and oil appliances—Present 10 per cent rate unchanged, but a long list of items added, including carboys, disposal units, dishwashers, clothes dryers, floor polishers, power lawn mowers, and some-type movie projectors. Appliances of industrial type are exempt.

**New Tax Bill Signed by President Is Bad News for Most U. S. Taxpayers**

WASHINGTON, Oct. 22 (AP)—The new tax bill signed by President Truman today is bad news for most taxpayers.

It means the new law will soften the tax impact slightly on a few business and farm groups.

There are one way a business man can cut his tax load: The new law makes it easier for him to take in the withholding tax on your pay checks almost right away, for the new higher rate begins to apply Nov. 1.

Taxes on many of the things you buy are going up, too. In many cases, this increase will be passed along to the buyer. Cigarettes, for instance, will go up about one cent a pack. A new car that costs \$2,000 today will cost about \$2,000.

The compromise tax bill which the President signed does give relief to some taxpayers, however.

Take a few typical cases:

Here's a bachelor with a net income of \$3,000 a year. His income tax is \$48 a year at present. Now it will go up to \$42.

Or consider a married couple with two children, net income \$5,000 a year. Uncle Sam takes \$372 from them now. After Nov. 1 he'll take \$371.
