

HANDICAPPED BY INEQUALITIES
Judging from the number of letters the
Imes-News is receiving from disgruntled
citizens, our courts and juries are being
samed more and more for the mounting toil
of tragedies on Magic Valley's highways.
Some of these letters are far-fetched in
their criticisms and comparisons of certain
court actions, particularly those cases involving traffic law violations, but many others
develop fairly good lines of topic in pointing
out "inequalities in justice."
They bear out the line of thinking expressed by several law enforcement officials
at the governor's anciety conference in Boise
recently. They asked the question: What
good does it do carrest the traffic law violalor when the courts too often are inclined to
set him free or impose a penalty so inconsequential as to serve no purpose from a law
enforcement, standpoint?

When the Magic Valley safety-campaign was first launched approximately a year ago one of the weakest links in the combined drive was regarded as the public's indiffer-ence. Individuals serving on juries were in-clined to minimize the violators guitt in crive was regarded as the public's indifference. Individuals serving on juries were inciclined to minimize the violators' guit in traffic accidents even when fatalities were involved, and the average citizen frowned on turning in the license numbers of car's involved in traffic violations.

So far as jury service is concerned, the average juror is still more inclined to favor the defendant than to give due consideration to those who have been injured and killed. But the average conscientious citizen is changing his attitude about turning in the names of traffic law violators. Every week we have at least one or two instances of citizens you therefore the results. Just the other day a Twin Falls citizen took it upon himself to apprehend a drunken driver, who pleaded guity and was fined \$100-and costs and sentenced to seven days in jail, in addition to having his driver's license revoked.

This is an exceptional case, all around, of course, which demonstrates wholehearted cooperation in law enforcement working at its best.

But, as some of these letters to the Times-News point out, there are too many cases in which the offenders suffer little or no serious consequences for the violations which are endangering human lives throughout Magic Valley every day.

"What kind of Justice do we have?" one of these letters asks, "Lost night's paper gives the information that one 18 Jepar-old boy drove a car that killed a little girl. . and was turned loose by a jury. The same paper carried a story about another 18-year-old boy who was involved in an accident by running a stop sigh. He got a \$150 fine, five days in-jail, and a 30-day suspension of his license. How come?

How come?"
Of course, the evidence in these two cases may have been such as to bear out the different results, but the public is not inclined to accept some of the court actions and jury verdicts as readily as might be supported by law and procedure. There are altogether too many apparent inconsistencies which reflect against the courts and mitigate the more effective results which might otherwise be attained through the Magic Valley safety campaign.
