

Once again, a major union faces an opportunity to temper legitimate aspirations with statesmanlike reserve—in the interest of a sound economy and a sure defense.

First of all, no thought should be enter-tained of using a strike this time to enforce union demands. The U. S, rearmament program, up to now somewhat behind schedule, is at last getting into stride. A crippling shortage of steel might put it months off the desired pace.






