NATION IS SKEPTICAL

NATION IS SKEPPICAL
The post of national party chairman demands certain special, practical talents and background. Hence it is not surprising that President Truman bestowed the Democratic party generalship on a man well-grounded in the hurly-burly of organization politics.

Frank McKluney, the Indianapolis banker who got the job, is a veteran associate of the Frank McHale Democratic machine in Indiana. He needs no schooling in the hard slamming that marks a major campaign. He knows the aggressive techniques of party fund-raising.

fund-raising.

To those who looked for the President to select a man unsulled by the grime of political combat, McKlinne's appointment may be a disappointment. Yet a chairman who would fit this requirement of spotiess public attire, of alootness from the rough and tumble, would hardly fill the bill.

tumble, would hardly fill the bill.

McKinney's insugural remarks show, however, that the administration is not unaware of the unsavory atmosphere clinging to Demoratic national headquarters as a result of the Boyle regime. The proponents of purity were given recognition.

The new chairman went out of his way to assure that henceforth his office would be favor-dispensing, and the like. He announced he would waive the 335,000 salary the post normally carries with it.

Certainly these gestures are welcome to a

Certainly these gestures are welcome to a nation which wants the moral tone of government and politics elevated. But they must necessarily be taken with an attitude of reserve. For they may prove nothing more than fancy window-dressing for an untidy attaction.

Too much has already been unearthed in many quarters of the administration for the public to accept at face value any professions of good moral intent—however genuine. Hod Mr. Truman and his top officials themselves moved swiftly and courageously to cast out past offenders, skeptician would not now be so widespread. As it is, only the proof of improved performance is likely to impress the earnest citizen.

Mr. Truman, in acknowledging McKinney's accession to the chairmanship, did little to dispel the akepitclam. He chose to take no mote of, the moral issue conceded by McKinney. Instead he heaped abuse upon the Republican party as the alleged sole proprietor of the "loathsome technique" of political smear, slander and vilification.

Nobotly who prizes the American system would condone for an instant the excesses of politics. But students of U.S. history—recent times included—tend to distribute responsibility for such excess more impartially than does the President.

He was no help, either, in his rather arrogant insistence that only the Democratic party is "right" on the issues. His concept of a Democratic mortgage on righteousness seems to reduce to hypocrisy his reference to the "two-party system," since he manifestly is convinced the opposition is never deserving of victory.

McKinney's arrival on the national scene may truly signal the start of a better day for public morality. But the prospect would be far more heartening if his boss showed a disposition to admit error, to see some virtue in the "other side," to attack weakness and corruption in his party ranks with the full courage his high office demands.
