Cowboys Elect Permanent Directors, Lower Prices

Election of permanent directors and officers, a reduction in ticket prices and a talk by Eddie Leishman, president of the Salt Lake City Bees, highlighted the first annual meeting of the Magic Valley Baseball club, Inc., and a board of directors meeting that followed.

A reduction in ticket prices from 85 cents to the old 75-cent level was voted by directors following a general discussion. Prices for box seat reservations for the year will be \$15.50 with the box seat holder agreeing to purchase at least 30 regular season tickets.

Each box seat holder also will receive free a copy of the 1952 Pioneer league record book.

Stockholders confirmed the election of 10 directors and selected a new man to serve following a resignation from the temporary board of directors.

Temporary directors elected to permanent positions are: Roy Wallace Bond, Fred Purves and C. R. Sherwood, Twin Falls; Ray Bait, Bush, W. D. Wiseman, Hansen, Charles Anderson, Victor J. Henson, Hazelton, R. L. Turner, Rupert, Joe Peters, Burley, and Bill Adams, Pocatello.

Jack Christensen, Shoshone, was elected to the board of directors to represent the Lincoln-Blinne county areas. B. Trinkle, Shoshone, elected to the temporary board, reported he completed his duties.

Directors reaffirmed their selection of officers, including president, treasurer, secretary, and executive committee.

In his talk, Leishman told stockholders the organization of the Magic Valley club has impressed all Pioneer league directors. He commented on the building of an organization that was "sound from the beginning and should have great success."

He said baseball trends show an improvement after a bad year last season.

"The war scare has drained off a lot of young men from the game. These same men will be returning next year as the rotation programs get under way. There should be more players available in 1957 than there were in the past season," Leishman said.

He expressed confidence that ample players would be available to the Cowboys to field a team in Pioneer league competition. "I know you will get help and good help from other major leagues or the Coast League."

Leishman, who was associated with Twin Falls directly from 1930 to 1935 as a member of the New York Yankee scouting system, warned youngsters not to expect a team to play in Twin Falls in 1957. He said the team probably would play in Pocatello and the power displayed on the squads "probably never will be repeated on any class."

He told Cowboy leaders to look to the minor league meetings next month in Columbus as the place to secure definite player help, a good business manager and a field manager.

Directors voted to send Joe Clements, Twin Falls, to the 1957 minor league meetings. Leishman agreed to work with Clements in securing player-post-season contracts for the Cowboys. If possible, a member of the board of directors will accompany Clements.
