

For various reasons, however, some of these anne spokesmen hesitate to name those in whom they would place their confidence as the leaders qualified to bring this change

about. They have their ideas, however, and to our way of thinking it is not too early for the American people to share in that knowledge. It has become quite generally known, however, that Mr. Eccles, former head of the federal reserve, favors Senator Tata as the logical man to give this country the kind of leadership it needs as President. Although Mr. Eccles support of Tatt is on a non-political basis, that in itself is even more significant because it recognizes the Ohioan for what he is worth, rather thanfrom the standpoint of his political qualifications.
