

#### A TRIP TO THE MOON

Secretary Acheson's trip to Europe has far more significance than the average Ameri-can perhaps realizes. The future of the ad-ministration's principal foreign policy— economic and military aid to our ailies—may pend on just what Acheson accomplishes

togeth on Just what Achieson recompanies, if mything. There are a number of important angles in his connection. Pending Acheson's return, for instance, President Truman's advisers are urging that he withhold any demand for another \$4.000,000,000 for foreign grants. They believe it will be difficult to obtain this amount or anything like it, unless Secretary Acheson is successful in pulling some rabbit out of the hat.

In fact, they're beginning to realize that it will be impossible to wrangle large appropriations out of congress unless our allies, as former President Hoover puts it, "show a will to help fremselves."

Chus. in the diplomatic and political dis, Acheson's journey abroad is one of most fateful that an American statesman s made in these grievous postwar years.

Few people, perhaps, realize that more than 10 billion dollars for foreign add is set up in the new budget—more than twice what we gave away last year. It's nearly twice what we spend each year clucating all the public school children in the nation!

Ever-since the official budget-message-proposed 485.4 billion of estimated spending, there has been a great to-do in and out of congress, over what to-do about the gap between anticipated revenues of 371 billion and this monstrous outing.

The gap is \$14.4 billion. Should we raise taxes? Should the government borrow more?

These are questions being raised more and more emphatically as Secretary Acheson goes abroad on a mission seeking to justify the administration's plans for vasity increased expenditures on economic and millitary aid to our ailies.
