# Scholarships Reported for Youth Group

Mrs. Max Brown, president of the Twin Falls Music club, announced that the National Federation of Music Clubs is again offering the youth group scholarship to the junior division.

Junior applicants must not have reached their 17th birthday, and must be members of the club as of January 1, 1952. Applicants must be either instrumentalists or vocalists, and must be of good musical ability and need of financial aid. They may perform such compositions as are in their repertoire, not to exceed 20 minutes. ### U. S. Grocers Blast at OPS Price Rulings

WASHINGTON, March 14 (AP)—The grocery store owners and wholesalers in the United States today blasted the office of price stabilization. And just as they finished, a Massachusetts super market operator went hand with a huge porterhouse steak as a price for the berries.

The grocers swung from floor in denouncing OPS and the "unfair" of its regulation during its appearance before the senate banking and currency committee. The first in considering legislation to extend the defense production act, under which OPS operates.

The committee also heard William Green, American Federation of Labor, a strong control program, and Allan S. Kline, president of the American Farm Bureau Federation, who urged a relaxation of price and wage controls.

But it was the grocers who stole the show.

The three-pound, nine-ounce porterhouse and three lamb chops were brought along by the grocers, who operate super markets in Brooklyn and New Bedford, Mass. They return to the grocers the complaint against OPS meat regulations which he said force retailers to sell the same price for the same meat, which ordinarily would be cut away.

"Strategic" grocers

Bertrand Turner, head of the committee to investigate the cost of living in Cranston, R. I., lost money last year for the first time in the history of the "strategic" price... of inflationary OPS regulations.

Philip H. Harnish, controller for Safeway Stores, Inc., recommended that all price regulations be rescinded immediately.
