Man Held for Trial Here on Check Charge

Kenneth L. Vincent was bound over to district court Thursday afternoon after a brief hearing on a forgery charge in Twin Falls justice court. Bond was continued at \$1,000 and Vincent was remanded to the custody of the sheriff.

Three witnesses, Mrs. Hazel Pepper, Lawrence Bell and City Detective R. A. Frasier, were called by Prosecutor Max Lloyd. Vincent, who did not deny or admit any witness, agreed with their testimony.

Mrs. Pepper said she cashed the \$50 check for Vincent at the Twin Falls Safety store. She said she did not know at the time if the name allegedly forged to the check was that of the man who gave him the check or not. Vincent admitted he signed the back of the check.

Bell said he never saw Vincent before appearing in court. Bell said he did not sign the check and his name was spelled incorrectly on it. He also said he has never seen Vincent in the bank on which the check was drawn. Vincent admitted Bell was not the man who gave him the check and said he never saw Bell before.

Frasier described a conversation with Vincent in which a man named William Mayo, arrested here and returned to the state penitentiary for parole violation, was identified as the man who gave Vincent the check. Vincent admitted he did not see Mayo write the check, but Vincent admitted cashing it.

Accidents Cause Most Deaths for People Under 40

Accidents are the principal cause of death for people under 40 years of age, but heart disease takes the greatest toll after 40, according to a study of death causes among policyholders of the Mutual Life Insurance company of New York.

Nearly 40 per cent of deaths among policyholders under 40 were caused by accidents, notes Harold D. Cook, assistant manager here for the firm. Heart disease accounted for 18 per cent and cancer for 14 per cent. The percentages are based on nearly 11,000 deaths during 1931.

Between the ages of 40 and 50, accidents caused only 7 per cent of deaths while heart disease deaths accounted for 34 per cent and cancer 20 per cent. Only 2 per cent of people over 60 were killed by accidents while heart disease killed 67 per cent and cancer 18 per cent.

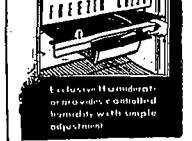

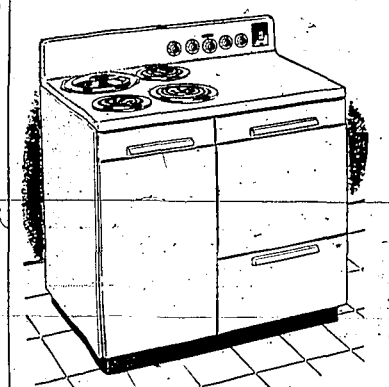
