

in effect petition congress to act on a proposal
which they have already endorsad. Congress
then must call a constitutional convention to
act on the amendment.
At this point the constitution is vague. It
does not say that the convention must draft
and approve the amendment advanced by the

perhaps guided by legal decisions, some
people interpret the convention as being
"charged" with the duty of following the 32
states wishes.

Modern war being what it is, the delay involved in the constitutional process could be disastrous, even if the machinery were vastly appeaded up to fit the occasion.




