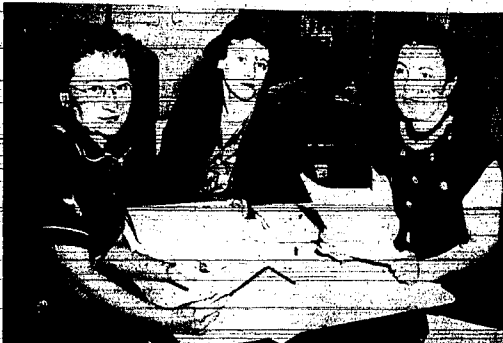

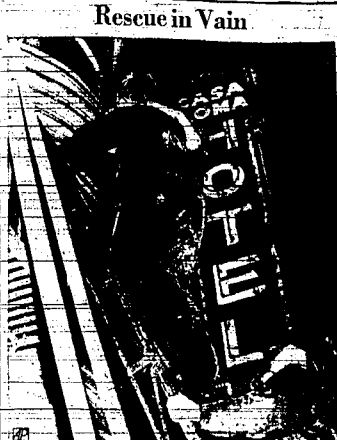

### Monument at First A-Bomb Spot Debated

WASHINGTON, April 3.—(AP)—Government officials are planning a national monument to atomic violence at the scene of the first A-bomb explosion.

The scene is a sandy patch of desert near Alamogordo, N. M., where at 8:30 a. m. July 16, 1945, man-made atomic energy "bombed" the world.

About all that left as a reminder of that occasion is the "atomium" shrine, a small, white, cylindrical structure, 15 ft. high, 10 ft. in diameter, which was the only structure that survived the blast.

The place is to be dedicated to the remembrance of the atomic age, and the monument will be a fitting reminder of the atomic age.

The atomic energy commission, for health reasons, had planned recently to erect on the crater, and had a contract for the project, Gov. Edwin L. McInnes, New Mexico, objected. He said the crater should be preserved as a historical monument.

There were conferences in New Mexico, yesterday, over the idea. Gov. McInnes, Alamogordo, N. M., and with officials of the atomic energy commission, defense department and the interior department, took place.

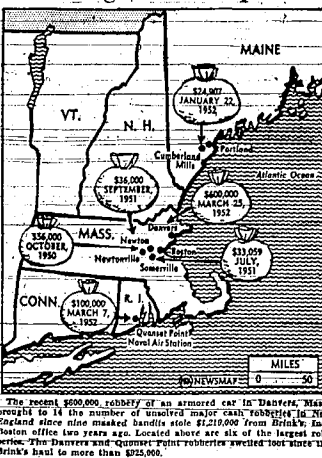

He said afterward that he agreed to work out plans for preserving part of the crater and, eventually, building a museum on the site. However, a replica of the first bomb and the instruments used in the first test, to be preserved all the place, since the crater has carried away many small chunks of it as souvenirs.

### Weather Gains Credit for Cut in State Auto Fatality Figure So Far This Year

BOISE, April 3.—Thanks to the bad winter weather which coated Idaho highways with ice and snow, traffic fatalities in the Gem state so far in 1936 are far below the same time last year.

Twenty-six persons were killed on the state's highways in the first three months—13 less than through March 31, 1935.

"State law enforcement officials give the weather credit for the decrease. SLICK HIGHWAYS kept people at home. Those who drive are much more careful than usual."

There may be more bent fenders and shattered windshields, but the cars which do slither into each other on the icy roads aren't going as fast and fewer people are killed.

Figures for the past few years bear this out. Traffic deaths for the first quarters of 1945 through 1948 ranged from 77 to 98. They came the big bulk of 1945, 84, and traffic deaths for the first three months of 1948 added down to 71.

Weather-burst records show that, in the first three months of 1947, 77 traffic deaths were counted, the weather was generally mild. In 1947, traffic deaths were counted in March. Traffic deaths increased to 10 in 1946 when weather was normal, and to 26 in 1947 during a warm, mild winter.

### Two Services Ban Diaries by Envoys

WASHINGTON, April 3.—(AP)—The army and air force have issued new regulations forbidding their attaches in foreign posts to keep diaries, it was disclosed today.

The regulations grew out of the disclosure last month that a communist agent had stolen and photostriped the secret diary of Maj. Gen. Robert W. Gray while in a U. S. military attaché at Moscow.

The diary urged immediate war with Russia. Communist propagandists have published it as "proof" that Americans are "warmongers."

A spokesman said the navy is considering issuing a similar regulation banning the keeping of diaries by naval attachés.

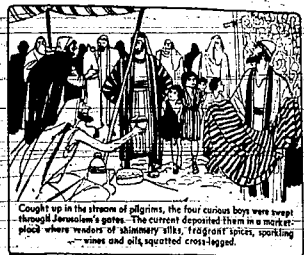

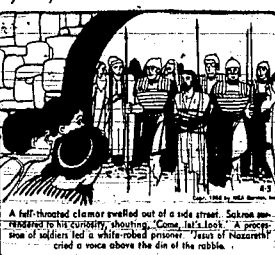

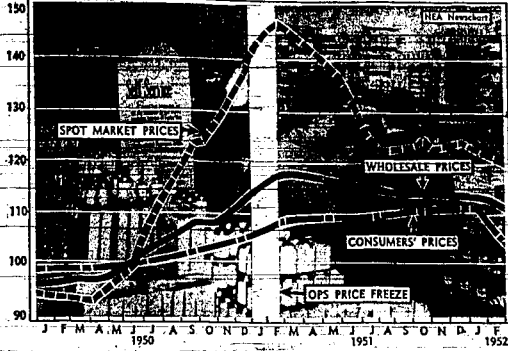

OAKLAND, Calif., April 3 (AP)—Kaiser Steel corporation has reached a new wage agreement with the CIO United Steel Workers union, giving 4,700 Pomona, Calif., plant workers a 17½-cent hourly increase and other benefits.

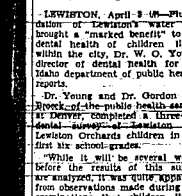
