

S. Clamps Ban On Steel Delivery For Civilian Uses

WASHINGTON, April 7 (AP)—The government banned all deliveries of steel for civilian use in a move to save supplies for high priority defense needs in case of a steel strike. The threat of a nationwide steel strike at 12:01 a. m. (EST) Wednesday, National Authority Chief Henry H. Fowler ordered an immediate freeze on all steel in a move to handle in any warehouse or mill. Fowler said steel actually in transit may be used, but all other deliveries were halted.

Phone Strike Starts As 65,000 Walk Out

NEW YORK, April 7 (AP)—More than 66,000 telephone workers went on strike across the nation today and threatened a "hit-and-run" disruption of service in 45 states and the District of Columbia. The strike started at 6 a. m. Combined with the five-day-old strike of Western Union operators, it confused and limited the nation's communications. But the telephone strike was effective immediately in only four states—New Jersey, Ohio, Michigan, and Northern California.
