## Industry Charges Federal Stalling as J. P. Steel Decision Pushes Plea

WASHINGTON, April 10 (UP)—The steel industry accused the government of "stalling" today as a federal judge turned down a request to speed up action on the proposed President Truman Federal Judge David A. Pine denied a request by four steel companies for a speed-up hearing on the merits of their claim that Mr. Truman seized the steel mills unlawfully. Justice department attorneys objected to the speed up. Pine then ruled he had no power to order it.  
Assistant Atty.-Gen. Holmes A. Baldrige said the government was entitled to a full 60 days to answer the industry complaint and would insist on having it.

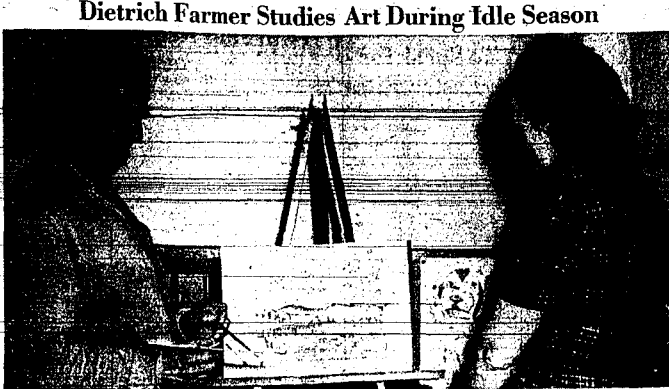

Carpenter reported results have been dramatic in the field of preventive medicine with emphasis on venereal diseases and tuberculosis.

He said in the last four years the number of reported cases of venereal disease has dropped 68 per cent. He pointed out the drop was so great that the Boise rapid treatment center had to be closed for lack of sufficient number of patients to make its operation feasible. Treatment is given now by private physicians in cooperation with state health officials.

### Commentator; Solon Tangle Over Charge

Montgomery denied the charge during the heated, gavel-pounding session. "Chronological" charge.

Penney and Chairman Harold D. Cooley, D. N. C., said Montgomery had sought to bring the program into "disrepute" by asking whether it was a "boondoggling" project prolonged for the benefit of job-holders and "grifters."

Montgomery replied he had made no accusations and cast no aspersions on the program. He was just "asking questions" raised by other persons.

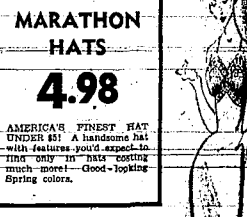

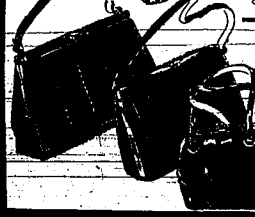

### Lengthy Fight Predicted for Seizure Moves

WASHINGTON, April 10.—The government can seize and operate a strike-threatened private industry like steel in the absence of clear-cut legal authority is headed for a showdown.

But the final answer is unlikely to be known for months, if that long, unless the law have to come from the supreme court. And even then congress might have the last word.

President Truman set the stage for the big court battle Tuesday night when he directed Secretary of Commerce Sawyer to take over operations of the strike-threatened steel mills.

The prohibition dollar industry was quick to challenge Truman's authority, it brought suit for an injunction—of course not to prohibit the government from seizing the steel plants. But it lost as the price was set.

Wednesday's hearing before a federal judge was only the first round. The issue almost certainly will be argued all the way up to the nation's highest court.

A quick settlement of the industry's war with the CIO Steel Workers union appeared to be the only thing that would halt the loss of a showdown.
