This notice will continue to be affixed until October 25, 1966.

- 3. The Ford Motor Company and Dearborn Motors Corporation shall have a period of time, expiring not later than December 31, 1952 in which to
- 4. All other claims and counter claims are dismissed and withdrawn on the merits.


