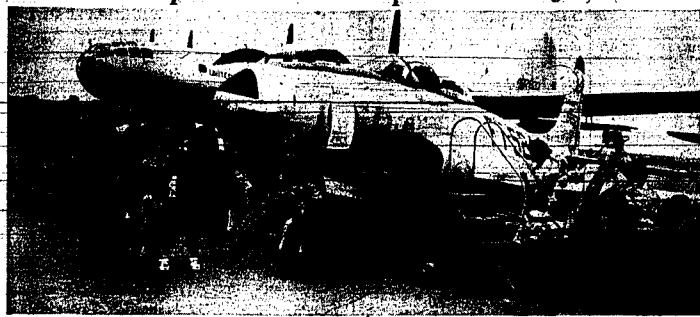

Planet Moves Close, Takes Brilliant Hue

By J. MUGH PRATT
A high school boy who intended to write in a column for the "Journalist" class last week always when he wrote, "I am writing to you on Mars, the god of war," he was writing to Mars, the planet. Mars is now a brilliant object, and is rising in the east-southeast approximately one and one-half hours after sunset. It may be seen at its nearest approach to us, a distance of almost 35 million miles, and will be rising shortly after sunset. It is decidedly red and orange in color.

Once in a little over two years Mars gets relatively so near to us that it is very brilliant. But only once in 15 or 17 years are these "approaches" so close as this year's. In 1939 our earth will be less than 35 million miles from Mars as bright as Jupiter, or about two and one-half times brighter than it will appear this year. The next very close approach will occur in 1946.

Smaller Than Earth
The diameter of Mars is only about one-half that of the earth. Its average distance from the sun is only 37 million miles, or about one and one-half times its distance from the earth. It is only 1/10 the size of our planet, and its day is only 24 hours and 37 minutes long. It is the only planet in our solar system that has a day almost exactly the same length as ours.

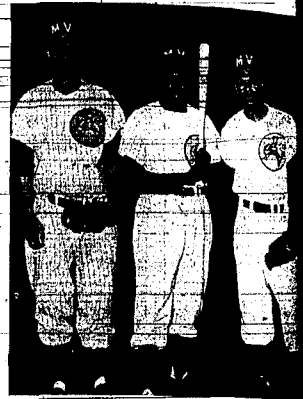

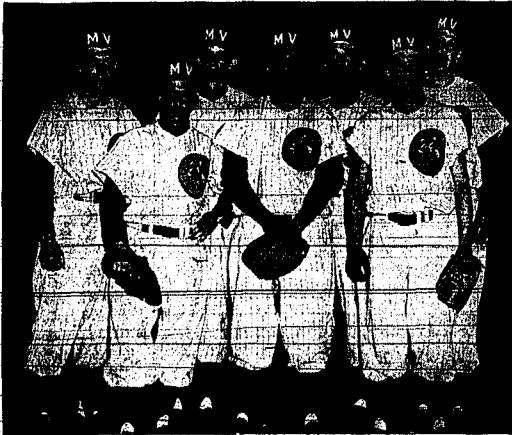
