Bureau Asked to Continue Study of Blaine Damsites

HAYLEY, April 28—Directors of the Lower Wood River Water Users' association, following a meeting Saturday with O. M. Brown, assistant regional planning engineer for the bureau of reclamation, E. G. Hart, district planning engineer, W. L. Stevens, hydrologist, and W. A. McCroon, engineer of the reclamation department, decided to ask the bureau to complete its survey for feasible damsites in Blaine county. It was pointed out that insufficient storage space and inadequate water supply at the Warm Springs creek site make this dam impractical. Only 20,000 acre feet of water could be stored here. Engineers said the Boulder flats site would store 150,000 acre feet. However, a site near Lake Creek, three and one-half miles north of Ketchum—called the Upper Ketchum site—was favored by the engineers. They said it would be possible to store 100,000 acre feet with a cost moderately above the cost for a dam at Boulder flats. Waters from the north fork of Wood river and several other smaller side streams entering the main stream south of Boulder flats could be impounded. Hart said he understood that approximately 20,000 acres of land would come under this project. Of this amount 5,000 acres now have adequate irrigation water, while the other 15,000 acres need storage water. Under a 45-year government contract the cost of water to the user at the reservoir, would be approximately \$6.50 per acre foot per year for the 150,000-acre-foot capacity dam. Under what is known as the 0-5 contract—the government water users would not obtain possession of the dam. Brown pointed out that water would be supplied annually at a cost of approximately \$3.94 per acre foot at the reservoir. Recreational and flood control ad-

"Wait and See" When a reporter wished him "good luck in the campaign," Eisenhower said, "Well, we will have to wait and see if I get in the campaign."

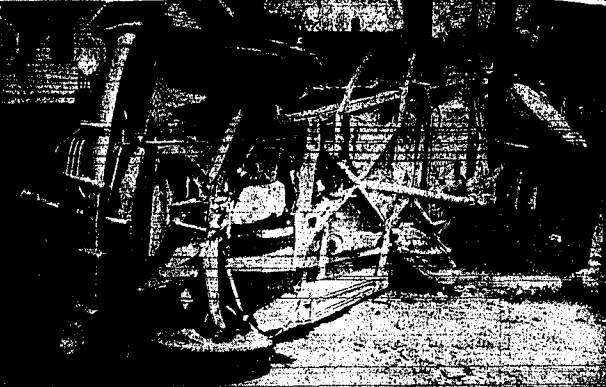
He indicated earlier "this month he would not campaign for the presidency unless and until he won the Republican nomination."
