### Spud Supply Decline Also Felt in Maine

PORTLAND, Me., May 12 (AP)—Maine, the nation's largest potato producer, is in the grip of a spud shortage.

A sampling of the state's wholesale and retail operators indicated short supplies still are distressing. But growers told the Bangor News and the Associated Press growers are willing to ship around won't go without.

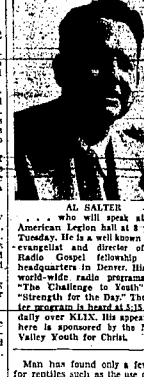
Many wholesalers said they would have to pay for above asking prices if they bought in the Boston market and also would be purchased other produce in what the trade calls a "package deal."

RUPERT, May 12—It's propa- ganda, but what? Mrs. Vosska, school sixth grade teacher, has had the unique experience of receiving a box of toys from Europe. And for a year prior to receiving the gift box she has received several airmail and registered letters and packages. All the mail came from a sister of her sister-in-law in communist Czechoslovakia and seems to carry some hidden message. The toys, received just before Xmas, obviously were intended for Mrs. Vosska's grandchildren in Lone-Island, New York. They included a small tin piano, hand carved dolls, biscuits, purses and crayons. One theory of Mrs. Vosska is the possibility of communist propaganda that America is in desperate straits and that not many of the children here have toys. Also in the package was a large book of excellent photographs of scenes in Prague. Only a few small children and their parents' all young-ster, are shown on the cobbled streets. One of the significant photographs is the drugstore owned and operated by her brother-in-law for many years, with a "closed" sign on the window. Mrs. Vosska's previous letter from Matylda Martinkova had indicated their mutual brother-in-law and his daughter, Alexandria, were working in a chemical magazine. The book has a Russian preface, which Mrs. Vosska hopes to have translated. The letters are written in excellent English and "more express a desire to visit with American relatives. Do they indicate a hope that they may escape from behind the iron curtain? Mrs. Vosska feels this is the most logical solution to the mysterious mail. In commenting on a package of travel folders, wrapped in a Czech flag with an outside wrapper of "my paper" the teacher said, "I presented were notes and choruses songs, a top dance routine by Dixie Lee Little, Lucille Band numbers and tableau scenes from American history."
