

Strong Winds Spread Havoc Through Utah

SALT LAKE CITY, May 16 (AP)—A windstorm swept through Utah early today, leveling many trees and blowing away roofs and light poles. Three big power lines were blown over, threatening Salt Lake City power supply. Telephone connections with the Pacific northwest also were severed.

18 Planes Damaged
Winds reached a velocity of 85 miles an hour in the Ogden area. About 18 light aircraft at the Ogden municipal airport were damaged. Three were blown over on their backs. Two in Ogden and a short circuit at the airport also were damaged. Glass windows were smashed and wires were knocked to the ground.

Crews Working
Three of Utah Power and Light company's 100,000-volt transmission lines were blown over. Crews are searching for the damaged sections. Officials said the lines apparently topped off at points where they were erected. An inch of snow covered the ground at Price. Trains were stopped and damaged by Price canyon winds.

Lines Knocked Out
The heavy winds knocked down a barn near Willard in northern Utah. The wreckage blocked the telephone line, cutting off service between Salt Lake City and Reno, Oregon, and Washington. Crews worked at top speed to restore service by afternoon. Lines were rerouted through other sections of the country, said Franklin C. Greer, Utah power director. Mountain States Telephone and Telegraph company's lines were down in some places.

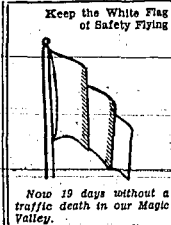

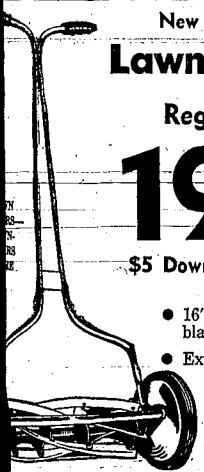

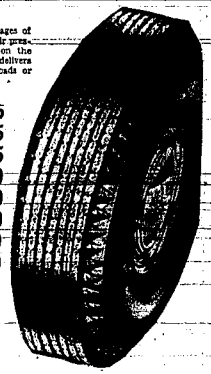

Pollution Is Discussed by Idaho Group

LEWISTON, May 15 (AP)—Water pollution, traffic control and law enforcement were subjects of discussion at the annual convention here Thursday.

W. J. Peterson, state administrator of the Idaho Department of Health, said "rapid progress" is being made in reducing water pollution for the state.

"We hope to get favorable action from the legislature next year," Peterson said.

A preliminary survey, headed by the governor's water resources advisory committee, was presented to the legislative committee. It called for:

1. A state policy to protect and maintain water resources.
2. Administration through the state health department.
3. Powers to adopt and maintain a comprehensive pollution law, conduct research, activities, adopt a policy on water quality standards, all cities to improve their water and sewer systems.
4. Control of discharges of waste into streams.

Traffic discussed

J. W. Bolton, State Traffic Commissioner, said that the state panel discussion that the main traffic problem of the state is "proper allocation of road use between the gasoline tax and automobile registration."

Highways should be classified as to use in local systems, he said. The chief should be to have a system of highways that will include those roads which primarily benefit the state and those that will have the same total of mileage as the present system.

New Increase for Newspaper Hinted

CANADIAN, May 15 (AP)—Publisher Edith Arnall said today that she has indicated it will permit a 10 per cent increase in the price of newspaper, effective June 15.

Arnall said she has registered with the state a request for the increase to be permitted.

The U. S. rate is 10 per cent of the newspaper's supply and distribution. The price increase would raise the price of Canadian newspaper, delivered at New York, to \$1.15 per copy.

Last July 1, Canadian newspaper went up from 10¢ to \$1.15 per copy, delivered at New York.

Reds Claim U. N. To Use Captives

TOKYO, May 15 (AP)—Police radio said today the United Nations command friends to return captured communists in Korea as "common leaders" for South Korea and national China.

The Chinese communist broadcast said this is the reason captives on Koryu Island have demanded that all prisoners be returned to their homes.

It did not mention that only 70,000 of the 109,000 prisoners in allied stockades want to go back.

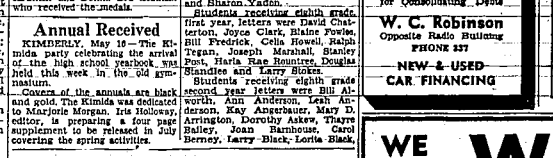
