PANMUNJOM, Korea, May 23 (AP)—Negotiators here agreed to take a three-day recess Friday to take a short recess. The United Nations proposed the recess to give the negotiators a chance to "reconsider our position." The recess begins today.

Armistice Predicted
Despite the recess, Gen. Adm. C. Turner Joy, retiring head of the U. N. delegation, predicted that eventually would result in an "equitable and honorable armistice."

Joy's statement: "Gen. William K. Harrison, sent a firm 'no' message to his first full day as senior delegate.

He suggested the recess after the meeting had created the allies of mistreating prisoners of war, 'massacres' in the prison camps, and of using gas against the enemy. He said to determine which prisoners want to return to communist rule.
