"SMEAR" TACTICS

The "smear" as a tactic is as old as politics. But the last two decades have seen it elevated to still greater importance in political propaganda. Today we must study ...

That the users of the smear include so many who think of themselves as decent is a mark of what has happened ...

Perhaps such tactics will work for a while in a time when people are troubled about who the enemy is and when the ...

But sooner or later the elemental sense of decency of the American citizen will revolt against the injection of such poisons into the political bloodstream. Sooner or later the men who practice or condone the "smear" on a grand scale will be torn out of office ...

One of the most diabolical modern experiences is to listen to a smear artist defending himself against charges he knows he cannot refute. It wraps himself in a cloak of righteousness, and declares that he is the victim of a smear. Recognize the technique? It's straight out of Moscow.

Political politicians have within the last five years sunk to depths not equalled for a long time. Regard for truth, for honest presentation of issues and men, has slipped into the background. Men of right ...

In the month or more before the 1952 national conventions, we will be in for some intense politicking, particularly on the national side in the fight between Senator Taft and General Eisenhower. Bitterness is already afloat between the camps, and seems sure to mount as nominating ...

It behooves all sides in both parties to take stock as they go into this critical period. The degenerative process in political debate has already gone too far. Men of real moral fiber are challenged, in the immediate days and beyond, to arrest the trend and restore political campaigning to a level of decency.

DON'T FAUL YOUR COUNTRY There are a number of things the people of this country should not forget for a moment as the national election draws nearer and nearer.

Here are eight significant facts for instance, they should keep in mind: 1. It is little over a year that the present national administration has collected more taxes than all the other administrations in American history collected in 186 years.

2. At present rates, the national spending, the tax bill averages \$1,589 per family for the whole country.

3. With the planned spending of more than \$6,000,000,000 the tax bill would jump to \$1,936 per family.

4. Our government owes \$260,000,000,000—more than twice as much as all the money in the United States.

5. The average family's share of this debt is \$5,880. Every child-born today inherits a debt of about \$1,500.

6. It costs twice in taxes just to pay the interest on the debt every year—about \$8,000,000,000. That comes to nearly 140 tax dollars per family annually!

7. And our government is getting bigger—fast. There are 2,500,000 civilians on the federal payroll. About one worker in every government is employed by federal, state or local government.

8. The 1953 federal budget of \$85,400,000,000 is greater than all the incomes of all the people west of the Mississippi!

9. Wasteful, unnecessary, wasteful government spending is back because it in turn brings in its train five evils:

1. Still higher taxes. 2. Still higher prices—inflation. 3. A still bigger national debt with its burden of interest. 4. More government control—socialism. 5. More corruption in government. Surely the time has come for the citizens to do something to put a halt to this degenerative trend in our government.
