



SELF-HELP NOT DEAD

To listen to a lot of people you'd think the federal government was just about the only place to turn for money, no matter what the need. They ought to watch the operations of a growing American institution known as the "Tolsthon"

"Telethon."

The Telethon is a marathon program on television, usually conducted by one or two entertainment stars who lead a vast parade of professional talent before the cameras over a 12 or 15-hour span.

The cause has—usually been some fund—relating noriset for research or treatment.

The cause has usually seen some fund-ralising project for research or treatment. In the field of a stubborn maindy like cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy, or heart disease. But the moist tevent one was dedicated to getting money to send the American Olym-pic team to Heisthit this summer, Witnessing a performance like this, you can hardly believe that the old American spirit of self-help is dead. For the Olympic Telethon, the goal was \$55,000.

Perhaps it would have been easier to ask congress for the funds but there is a tra-dition against that. So Olympic officials ap-pealed to the people of the United States. With Bing Crosby and Bob Hops leading the way, stars of stage, screen and TV, ath-letes and assorbed other public figures made a 15-hour procession across Hollywood and New York TV stages. There were dozens of

a 15-hour procession across Moliviwood and New York TV stags. There were dozens of voluntest ellephone-workers, auditora, chackers, and other technical helpers. Altogether, nearly 1,200 people pitched in for the Olympic cause, donating their full services in, an all-night ordeal.

When it was all over at mid-afternoon on a Sunday, the Telethon, scoreboard showed that more than, \$1,000,000 had been raised from individuals, companies, institutions and the like. The contributions ranged from driblets of \$1 and \$5 to big chunks of \$13,000. Quite an accomplishment for a half day of effort, however intensive that effort may have been. Quite a tribute, too, to the generous-hearted impulses of the American people who gave their dollars to send our team abroad.

To be sure, many gave money with the assurance that their names or those of their business enterprises would be mentioned over a coast-to-coast network. But \$2111, they gave. Of course it never has been true that the urge to mutual-self-help was hopelessly enfectively and the self-help was h
