

THE STRIKE WEAPON

For some time we have been scraping along with a slim output of steel. Inevitably the nation will suffer. And that includes the steel workers themselves.

worker themselves.

Every time a major strike occus, some enterprising fellows always tot up the economic losses, in output, wages, profits and so on. The bill is generally staggering.

Maybe the time will come when we will regard these losses as too great to bear. In the complex state of our industrial organization, in the precarious state of our relations with the communist world, time is of supreme value. The time that is thrown away when men strike can never be regained.

That time spelia money in workers pockets.

It spells in this instance, steel for guns and
