BRITISH EMOTIONS

There are times when British labor party leaders sound like hysterical schoolgitis. This seems to be one of them. Their emotionis tirades over our large-scale bombing of the commynists' Yalu river power plants hardy qualify them as sober world satesumen.

Clement Attlee and Aneurin Bevan, remarkably in agreement for one, acream that war with Red China has been brought closer by our action. They declare also that it si-fects adversely the truce tasks at Panmunjom. As far as the truce tasks go, it is hard to see how they could be any worse than they are

As far as the truce talks go, it is hard to see how they could be any worse than they are eight now. They have been in progress for exactly a year, and for the last several months no constructive steps have been taken. The reds are using them for a double purpose; to clock their buildup behind a vastly stronger line in North Korea, and to spout victors propagands like the fake charges against the U. N. on germ warfare. Whether war—big war—has been brought nearer by the power plant bombings is doubtful.

Attee and Bevan do not appear to have studied communist behavior closely. Expert students of the reds will tell you that they are not likely to be provided by any affied more unless they want to be. In other words, we make a mistake if we assume they will react in accord with the patterns of international behavior to which we are accustomed.

Jacob Malik calmly walked in one day and took his seat. When we agreed last year to undertake truce talks, we took a calculated risk. But they ough thardly to complain about it, since they readily acquiesced in the furner talks that uitimately worked to the reds advantage. This is merely one effort to re-balance the scales.

Amid the emotional torrent that flooded out from fearful British hearts, the words "fed up with Korea" were heard. Do Attlee and Bevan-and their cohing, chroux liminging that we in America are any less fed up than they?

SOLDIER VOTE PROBLEM

Getting members of the armed services on active duty to vote by absentee ballot is a problem. There are now an estimated 2 1/2 million men of voting age in uniform.

Sightly over a million of them; come from 25 states which still have laws that restrict voting by servicemen and women, particularly those on duty oversens.

Twenty of these states allow only 15 to 30 days in which to apply for and turn in absentee ballots. It just enough time.

Two atates, New Mexico and South Canna, allow no absentee voting by servicemen. Texas allows no absentee voting by men in the regular force, though national guardamen, and reservists may vote by mail. Five states permit force, though station guardamen, Delaware, Louisiana, South Carolina and Utah.

The federal soldier vote bill which President Truman saked congress to pass before it adjourned would remove these restrictions and give all members of the armed forces equal rights to cast their ballots by mail.
