Valley's Boy Scouts Begin Annual Camp

Two hundred fifty-one Snake River district Boy Scouts from 10 Magic Valley Scout troops have registered to attend summer camp programs at Lightfoot Bar and Percupine Springs, reports George Brethren, local Boy Scout field executive.
Summer camp program opens Saturday at the two camps. Each camp period lasts one week with the program closing Aug. 2.
The Percupine Springs camp is located in the Magic Mountain area. Camp Lightfoot Bar is on the south fork of the Boise river, and Brethren field executive.
Camp facilities at Lightfoot Bar handle 12 troops or from 200 to 250 Boy Scouts. Percupine Springs camp capacity is approximately eight troops.
The camps open at noon Saturday. Upon arrival, troops are given medical examinations and assigned camp areas. Camp sites are set up the first day.
Sunday's program opens with morning church services. Individual troops determine their own Sunday schedules.
The official scouting program begins Monday with training in ax, knife, compass work and other phases of pioneering.
Hikes, contests, raft races, campfire activities, courts of honor and games of review round out the week's program.
Approximately 1,000 Boy Scouts are expected to participate in the summer program, Brethren said.
