ow that the general public is becoming and more interested in two of our counmore and more interested in two or our coun-try's greatest social problems, there is good reason to believe that Idaho's second annual symposium on alcoholism and drug addiction, to be held in Boise, Aug. 28, will be well at-

with an outstanding speaking program ar-ranged and all sessions open to the public, this year's symposium should pave the way for even greater efforts along these lines in Idaho during the coming year, and it's a suboh should he given serious consideraject which should be pro-tion by the next legislature.

it's recognized from coast to coast that Americans, as a nation, are a pretty hard-drinking crew, and as such very often carry

drinking crew, and as such very otten early things too far.

In fact, the problem of alcoholism, when recognized for the extensive national ill that it is, becomes disturbingly serious. There are few or us who, right in our own lives, have not been touched at some time by the effects of too much drinking.

It can be a brother-in-law, a father, a cousin, son or a good friend. It can even be a sister or a mother. Tippling unfortunately into confined to men.

Happlily, the extent and nature of the problem have been recognized by our top medical men and by the government. It's well understood now that alcoholism is a disease with mysterious and hidden roots, and it is being stacked as such.

One of the country's biggest problems now it is being the people to realize that this is the case—to encourage them to be sympathetic, understanding, considerate, tolerant and helpful. With an understanding American public, much greater strides can be made in combatting both alcoholism and drug addiction. Prejudice has been one of the greatest stumbling blocks in lighting these social problems in times past.

One of the leaders in research on the sub-ject of alcoholism is the Yale university center of alcohol studies. Numerous other schools have similar programs.

Mahlin-B. Hansen, former director of the state department of exceptional education, who is largely responsible for the symposiums being conducted in Idaho, is a graduate of Yale's school of applied physiology studies on alcohol.

This year he has won the further distinction of being awarded a scholarship and fellowship by the institute of Scientific Studies for the Prevention of Alcoholism at Washington, D. C. This year's institute will be conducted at Loma Linda, Calif., Aug. 4-15, during which time Mr. Hansen will continue his advanced studies on this important subject.

advanced studies on this important subject.
On the non-scientific side of this subject is Alcoholics Anonymous. In that nation-wide organization, former alcoholics have done wonderful work in helping others to get back on the right track.
Then, too, special drugs have been developed, such as antabuse, which makes a proposed as a subject of the drinks alcohol.
For some years, business and industry have been aware that alcoholism is one of the greatest destroyers of personal efficiency. It has been estimated that alcoholism among employee costs the nation's industry millions of dollars annually. That includes absentee issuan accidents, errors, inefficiency and poor public relations.

In New York City certain industries have gotton together to see what can be done about the matter. First they attended a conference aponsored by the new consultation clinic for alcoholism at New York university-Believue medical center.

There, the industrial representatives heard explanations from experts who described the whole problem facing industry. Then, they were invited to send to the clinic for treatment, thus not their properties who described the medical contents of their remisers when the problem facing industry.
